

## Materials list

Rubber gloves, apron

Plastic from dry cleaning bags or light weight plastic to wrap fabric in to take it home

Freezer Paper- sold at grocery stores – you can share with others

Seam Ripper \*\*\*\*\* sold at sewing store

Scissors for paper.

T-pins for pinning work down, straight pins will work.

Fabric- can be 100% cotton, silk or rayon that is prepared for dying- a yard or two.

Blank silkscreen frame- at least 12” x 18”- but can be bigger, if you have one.

Paper towels or old hand towels for cleaning up.

\*\*Padding for your work table, something that can be pinned into like flannel,,thick plastic for insulating floor, foam core or insulation board works well.

Material Fee- \$10 for dyes and chemicals

**I will have cotton fabric for sale for approximately \$8 a yard.**

**I will also have silk scarves available if you want them. They are approximately \$12**
