### From Pastor Bill's Study

Greetings to all,

While doing my devotions this morning I came across a story that intrigued me so I thought I would share it with you. It is a story that speaks to the nature of Christ and his connection to the Jewish faith.

It deals with the story of triangles and one of their meanings in conveying a word picture to help us understand the connection of God to us through Jesus the Christ. The meaning of Passover is also interwoven into the story along with the picture of Christ on the cross. Both events center on the breaking of slavery and the beginning of freedom for those who will accept the freedom offer through God and through Christ.

The first symbol is that of the doorways of those who heard the call of Moses to anoint their door post so the angel of death would see this symbol and pass over that house. The door post and the lintel to form a triangle pointing from the people up toward God.



They were looking up, seeking help from God to remove the burden of slavery and the promises of God for land given to Abraham. When they sought God's ways their prayers were answered and they were set free that night as the angel of death moved through the land. Those who trusted in God were set free.

When Christ died as a sacrifice for us during Passover his blood was also placed upon the doorway to heaven in the shape of a cross and there were three points of contact with his blood. With his hands and feet he formed another triangle.



This time the symbol is one of God looking upon the needs of the people and Christ offering himself to set us free from the slavery of sin and the start of the journey toward the promised land of heaven.

When we place these two triangles overlapping each other we come up with the symbol of the Star of David.



This symbol is one that unites the people of this earth reaching up to God for help in meeting their needs of freedom from sin and death. It also represents the symbol of God reaching down to the people in offering them the freedom they need the most. That is freedom from sin and the reuniting of God with the people and the people with God.

As Christians when we partake of Communion it is a uniting of these two principals, our need of salvation and that need being met in Christ.

We must never forget we are a Judeo Christian religion as we draw from the spring of Judaism to water the tree of Christianity. We cannot forget our past if we are going to live into the future.

"From our past will come the future: what it holds a mystery, unrevealed until its season, something God alone can see." \*

### Lay Leader's Report

My recent completion of a two-week District-sanctioned online Lay Ministry course on Biblical interpretation assures my continuing certification as a Lay Speaker.

I conducted the full Traditional service at Bethany on Sunday, July 1 and led that evening's Contemporary service while guest speaker Dave Gehrum of Watsontown UMC gave the sermon.

On June 28 the workers charged with the renewal of Milton's Front Street were treated to a free lunch of hot dogs, hamburgers, side dishes and beverages provided by Bethany and the T.I.M.E. organization as a "thank you" for the wonderful job they've been doing. The men were very happy with that gesture, with many of them saying that they rarely even get acknowledged by locals for their efforts, let alone in such a giving spirit. We salute Mike Longenberger for advancing the idea and doing the cooking, and we give an appreciative nod to the people of T.I.M.E. for their assistance with the preparations.

### Trustees....

As reported in the June newsletter, the Trustees approved replacing the Front Street entrance doors. We have chosen the door design and approved the shop drawings submitted by Baut Studios. Although we don't have a definitive date for the installation, hopefully the new doors will be installed in time for the Harvest Festival.

Another project we are working on includes lighting in several areas. We are hoping to brighten the lighting in the Front Street entrances and the 'tunnel' from the sanctuary to the sacristy. We are also looking into updating the exterior lights which light the stained glass windows at night.

I'd like to take this opportunity to provide a quarterly report of the Trustees finances. The following balances (rounded) are as of June 30, 2018:

- Hudock Capital Group \$658,847 a decrease of approximately \$23,500 from the last quarter –
  Although we went through a period earlier in the year when it was not necessary to draw from this
  account to fund the deficit in current expenses, we had to start drawing out \$10,000 per month for that
  purpose again the past quarter.
- Prudential Investments \$564,623 An increase of approximately \$5,500 from last quarter this is our 'in lieu of flood insurance' account.
- Prudential Investments \$83,831 The Radenbush Trust a decrease of approximately \$500 from last quarter.
- Prudential Investments \$6,487 An increase of approximately \$275 from the last quarter.
- BYN Mellon \$219,306 The Butler Trust a decrease of approximately \$730 from the last quarter, but this includes the normal quarterly withdrawal of \$2,625, which was deposited in the checking account for current expenses.


