THE AMERICAN SADDLEBRED HORSE BREEDERS FUTURITY OF COLORADO OPEN AND AMATEUR DIVISION

Open only to registered American Saddlebred Horses

PURPOSE: Futurities are held to encourage the breeding and showing of American Saddlebred Horses. The value of the foal entered in the Futurity is enhanced by having its earning potential increased; the value of the sire and dam may also be enhanced by successful progeny shown in Futurities. ALL FOALS MAY BE NOMINATED AND SHOWN IN BOTH OPEN AND AMATEUR DIVISIONS (Stallions and mares are nominated once. All others must pay separate for the OPEN and AMATEUR).

WHAT COLTS AND FILLES ARE ELIGIBLE? All colts and/or fillies shown must be the product of stallions and mares that have been previously nominated in the American Saddlebred Futurity of Colorado. For colts/fillies to remain eligible, nominations must be kept current through the foals weanling and yearling year, regardless of whether shown or not. IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE OWNER TO PROVIDE THE FUTURITY WITH PROOF OF ASHA REGISTRATION BY THE FIRST DAY OF THE SHOW.

HOW TO NOMINATE A SIRE: It is necessary that the fee of \$50 is paid to the Futurity on or before **JUNE 15th** of the year the foal is born. There is a grace period to July 1st and an Extended Enrollment until December 31st.

HOW TO NOMINATE A DAM: It is necessary that the fee of \$15 be paid to the Futurity on or before **JUNE 15**th of the year in which the foal is born. There is a grace period to July 1st and an extended enrollment until December 31st.

OPEN WEANLING DIVISION: (1) The Sire and Dam of the weanling must have been nominated in the Futurity the year in which the foal was born; and (2) a fee of \$40 must be paid to the Futurity on or before **JUNE 15th** of the year foaled. There is a grace period to July 1st with a \$10 late fee per horse and an extended enrollment until December 31st with a \$20 late fee per horse.

AMATEAUR WEANLING DIVISION: (1) The Sire and Dam of the weanling must have been nominated in the Futurity the year in which the foal was born; and (2) a fee of \$40 must be paid to the Futurity on or before **JUNE 15th** of the year foaled. There is a grace period to July 1st with a \$10 late fee per horse and an extended enrollment until December 31st with a \$20 late fee per horse.

OPEN YEARLING DIVISION: (1) The colt or filly must have been nominated in the OPEN DIVISION as a weanling up until the extended deadline of December 31st, but need not have been shown; and (2) a fee of \$40 must be paid to the Futurity on or before **JUNE 15th** of the Yearling year. There is a grace period to July 1st with a \$10 late fee per horse.

<u>AMATEUR YEARLING DIVISION</u>: (1) The colt or filly must have been nominated in the AMATEUR DIVISION as a weanling up until the extended deadline of December 31st, but need not have been shown; and (2) a fee of \$40 must be paid to the Futurity on or before **JUNE 15th** of the Yearling year. There is a grace period to July 1st with a \$10 late fee per horse.

HOW SHOWN: Entries shall be shown in hand, without curb bits or tail sets, and in accordance with the AHSA rules. Only two people per animal are permitted in the ring. Handlers and attendants must be neatly and appropriately dressed in clean and well fitted clothes. Each may carry or use a whip not exceeding 6' in length including lash; the lash shall not have been altered in any way. It must be a standard whip of suitable style. Exception: a small empty paper bag or ribbons may be attached to the whip. The small empty bag may be used separately. There shall be COMBINED classes for colts and fillies. ***NOTE: For colts/fillies to remain eligible, nominations must be kept current each consecutive year, regardless of whether shown or not.

HOW THE PRIZES ARE DIVIDED: All divisions shall payback as follows: monies will be divided equally among all divisions that have entries and then further divided so that the nominator of the sire and dam of the winning foal in the Open Weanling Division shall each receive \$50.00. The nominator of the sire and dam of the reserve foal in the Weanling Division shall each receive \$25.00, and then winner of the class shall take 40%, second 25%, third 15% and fourth 12.5%, and fifth 7.5%. All nomination fees and other moneys raised shall be paid out in prize money, after expenses. If a class does not fill, total prize money shall be paid out by increasing the above amounts according to the same scale. Dues collected may be used for Saddlebred Futurity promotional activities.

WHERE AND WHEN TO PAY FEES: All fees received by the Secretary of the Futurity must be postmarked by the closing date of JUNE 15th of the Futurity year. There is a grace period to July 1st with a \$10 late fee per horse and an Extended Enrollment for weanlings of December 31st with a \$20 late fee per horse.

<u>CHAMPIONSHIPS:</u> There shall be a championship for the following classes: Combined Open / Amateur Weanling Halter and Combined Open / Amateur Yearling Halter. All horses that show in a qualifying Open or Amateur class are eligible for the championship. Championships do not pay back.

<u>LIABILITY:</u> There will be NO return of payment paid. Any entry paid by a check, which does not clear (bad check), shall be null and void and the animal(s) in question will be ineligible. **If such a check exists it can be made good with a cashier's check or money order by the June 15th deadline (or grace period of July 1st), the entry will then be accepted with a \$50 return check fee. The right is reserved to reject any entry, and to debar any entry from competition for failure to comply with the conditions of the Colorado Futurity.**
