

Retribution Is Not The Answer | Sunday Service 02/23/2025



In the book of Exodus, God speaks to Moses and tells him the rules for retribution. In chapter 21:23–24, the rule is as follows; "But if there is serious injury, you are to take life for life, eye for eye, tooth for tooth, hand for hand, foot for foot, burn for burn, wound for wound, bruise for bruise." While this may seem rather drastic, it certainly allowed for equal retribution for ones injuries. This is also provided a viable deterrent by individuals who desired harm to another.

But that is not he rule we live by today. In Luke 6:31, Jesus says, "Do to others as you would have them do to you." In other words, if you desire to

be treated fairly and nicely, then you are to treat everyone else the same way. It sounds easy enough, but life does not always work that way. And while we have a justice system that works most of the time, often the victims may feel the need to exact some form of revenge on their own.

Last week we talked about trusting the Lord, and this week we will put that trust to the test as we look at situations we find difficuly and disturbing, and ask God to show us the way to trust His ways and not our own.


