

# Epiphany

*"I am thy servant; give me understanding, that I may know thy testimonies"  
(Psalm 119:125)*

Sometimes in life we come across something where we have no supernatural understanding of at all. We find ourselves baffled or perplexed by the circumstances in which we live. Your life is your journey from start to finish and each issue is a lesson for you to complete.

All day Sunday, I kept hearing the word "Epiphany." I knew instantly God wants to show Himself. He wants to reveal something to your heart. We all have had those moments where something suddenly becomes clearer, and God is wanting to bring clarity to your heart & mind. God is our source of understanding in all things.

God wants us to learn His ways and come to know Him, not just who He is. He hasn't changed, nor will He change, which includes His unstoppable love for us and His desire to show us things. God wants all of us (this includes you) to understand His ways. God has made many of His traits and attributes understandable.

As we pray for God's direction or heart on the matter we eventually (in God's timing and in His way) will see the "lights" would go on. I really sense that this week the "light" is going to come on for you in an area you've been seeking Him about.

This is called an epiphany and it means a moment when you suddenly feel that you understand, or suddenly become clearer. God knows there are some important things you've been desiring to understand better.

What good is God's Wisdom (His Word), without our being able to understand it and apply it to our lives? Psalms 119:130, "The entrance of thy words giveth light; it giveth understanding unto the simple."

Scripture assures us we can know God in nature (Romans 1). This is an innate, spontaneous, natural knowledge of God. Understanding God's works is an important part of understanding Him. We must have God's understanding of His Wisdom before we can begin to apply it to our lives. To receive understanding we need to recognize our position as Christ's servant who needs understanding.

This includes those moments in which you suddenly see or understand something in a new or very clear way. God wants you to share an experience with you where He opens your eyes to something that touches you deeply.

God wants to communicate with you. You have wanted to talk to God and get answers back. God will talk to you inside of your mind and heart. When God speaks to you, you will know it is God and there will be no doubt.

*"And we know that the Son of God is come, and hath given us an understanding, that we may know him that is true, and we are in him that is true, even in his Son Jesus Christ. This is the true God, and eternal life" (1 John 5:20).*
