SUBJECT: OXYTOCIN (PITOCIN)

ACTION:

Causes uterine contractions, causes lactation, slows post-partum vaginal bleeding.

INDICATIONS:

Post-partum vaginal bleeding.

CONTRAINDICATIONS:

Any condition other than post-partum bleeding, cesarean section.

PRECAUTIONS:

It is essential to assure that the placenta has delivered and that there is not another fetus present. Overdosage can cause uterine rupture and hypertension.

SIDE EFFECTS:

Anaphylaxis and cardiac arrhythmias.

DOSAGE:

IM: <u>3-10 units</u>

IV: <u>10-20 units in 1000 mL Isotonic Crystolloid</u> administered to uterine response.

ROUTE:

IM and IV drip

PEDIATRIC DOSE:

Not indicated.
