

(Think Newelled-out Penns, Trulines and such with an old Schnabel at the business end or something like that.)

My focus is strictly saltwater and primarily on So. Cal. sportfishing tackle from the 50's - 80's, and I plan to devote most of my prepared remarks to buying, selling and collecting gear from that era. I also love to read and talk about the early history of So. Cal. saltwater sportfishing when big game sportfishing was born at the Tuna Club, and the story of the San Diego and Terminal Island tuna clipper fleets and their crews who pioneered today's long range fishing grounds (and well beyond), and I collect anything that I can get my hands on (and afford) relating to those times. The boat was really nicely set up and Ralph commented on how clean it was. We had a gorgeous day on the water with a nice breeze the whole time. While they push it to 60 people fishing on the weekend and Tuesday (half price day), they only took 30-35 fishing on that Monday. Lots of space everywhere and plenty of places to sit. Once we fought off the mackerel attacks we were able to do some bottom fishing. While we saw a variety of fish, most everything for everyone went back in with few keepers. Ralph and William had 1 sand bass apiece and Denise had a decent sheephead but that was about it. Becky looked like she was going to be an early leader in sculpin throwbacks but then she limited herself to mackerel most of the day. Jackpot went for a 29 lb. Halibut-not ours. Seemed like this was a rest day for the captain & crew. But we enjoyed just being out there and each other's company so it was a great day anyway.



### **August 27<sup>th</sup> Tak Trip Written by Joel Tureaud**

The last week of August had been quite hot so I was really looking forward to getting out of the heat of the San Gabriel Valley.

Going through my fishing equipment I was sure not much rock fishing gear was needed. I decided to bring a jig rod, light 15 lb. live bait rod, bait casting curado set up with spectra and one heavy bait rig.

We headed out to Santa Cruz Island, fishing started out slow but Rich Jenkins hooked up very fast. BAM! BAM! BAM! Three kelp bass!

Jim Clough caught something he fought for a while, everyone was guessing white sea bass?, black sea bass?, mud marlin? Then pop! C-YA!

Paul Yazaki hooked up to another bottom dweller which turned out to be a bat ray..

Steve Kelly (captain) moved to a few more spots to get away from the birds, a couple of harbor seals, and sea lion pups.

We arrived at one spot where the water was clear. I dropped a cut piece of squid into the kelp stringer and watched a calico bass inhale the bait. The 15 lb rig received the most use. The fishing was not wide open but the quality was great. We caught sheephead, sugar bass, kelp fish, etc. My large calico weighed 4lb. 9 oz. Glenn Bummer's calico was in approximately 4lb. 8 oz. Dennis Dickson caught the other large fish which was a sheephead.

Rich Jenkins, Glenn Bummer, Gary Gillingham, Dennis Dickson, Jim Clough, Paul Yazaki, Laney Hackman, Mike Maurizio, Chuck Auer and Joel Tureaud were all the anglers on this great trip.

Christine Tureaud missed the trip and stayed home to babysit the new puppy.
