LUNCH TICKETS: Any unused lunch tickets on your account will roll over to the next school year.

KINDERGARTEN UNIFORMS: Kindergarteners will start wearing the regular school uniform for the 2025-26 school year.

SUMMER WORK: All students going into K-8th grades have summer reading and a required math packet that will be sent home on the last day of school, and are due on the first day of school in the fall.

VOLUNTEER HOURS: All volunteer service hours must be recorded in <u>Track It Forward</u> by June 6. **Unfulfilled volunteer service hours will be charged to your final tuition bill on June 9 at the rate of \$30/hour.** If you need to complete your volunteer hours, there are several opportunities available:
