

AN ORDINANCE STAGGERING TERMS OF OFFICE
OF TOWN COUNCIL MEMBERS

WHEREAS, the Cloverdale Town Council deems it in interest of the Town that the terms of office of Town Council members be staggered to provide continuity of administration, and

WHEREAS, the Town Council has selected Cloverdale Third District for a three (3) year term in the next general election, and

WHEREAS, the Town is authorized by I.C. 3-10-7 and I.C. 3-10-6-2.5(c) to adopt ordinances and provide for three (3) year terms.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF CLOVERDALE, INDIANA:

A. That the terms of office of Town Council members be staggered to provide continuity of administration.

B. That the representative from Cloverdale Third District shall be elected to a three (3) year term of office at the next Town election (1991).

C. The Cloverdale Third District Town Council members will thereafter be elected for a four (4) year terms (beginning 1995).

D. Notice of this ordinance shall be given to the County Election Board upon passage.
