Kindergarten Supplies

Tips for Home Story Time

- Pick a regular time for daily reading
- Find a quiet, comfortable place to read without television interruptions
- Make sure your child can see the pictures and words
- In easier books, point to words and reinforce left to right and top to bottom progression
- Make predictions or ask questions before and after you read with your child
- Read with your child for 10 – 20 minutes daily

Recommendations for Parent/Child Activities

- Read aloud to your child daily and reread favorite stories
- Walk and talk with your child/Stop and listen to your child
- Visit the library
- Read and discuss books
- Read road, store, or restaurant signs
- Encourage and provide materials for your child to draw, cut, color, and use clay
- Practice having your child follow a series of directions
- Cook and bake together and follow recipes, measure ingredients and observe changes with your child
- Focus on rhyming words that begin with the same sound
- Help your child to make independent choices (cheeseburger or chicken nuggets, Cheerios or Fruit Loops, etc.)/Involve your child in planning family activities
