The Feast of Candlemas occurs 40 days after Christmas on February 2, celebrating the Presentation of the Lord in the Temple. Mary and Joseph brought their baby Jesus to the temple to present Him to the Lord-God. When Simeon saw baby Jesus, he said, "For my eyes have seen your salvation which you prepared in the sight of all the peoples, a LIGHT for

revelation to the Gentiles, and glory for your people Israel." From these words comes the traditional Catholic practice of blessing candles. The feast features two main themes: light and the encounter between the Lord and his Church.
