MEMORANDUM FOR RECORD

SUBJECT: 2025 Psychological Operations Regimental Honors Program, Major General Robert A. McClure Awards Panel Results

1. On 9 October 2025, The Psychological Operations (PO) Proponent's Office hosted the annual Major General Robert A. McClure Awards Panel. The panel consisted of 13 members from across the Regiment, including PO Group Commanders and Command Sergeants Major, senior, mid, and junior leaders, representing both the Active and Reserve components, as well as the Regimental Honorary Leadership. Panel members attend in person or virtually.
2. The panel reviewed and voted on 122 Major General Robert A. McClure medallion nomination packets (6x Gold, 25x Silver, and 91x Bronze nominations). This year was tied with 2024 for the second largest number of nominations received in a single year throughout the program's history. Panel members approved or disapproved, recommended upgrade or downgrade, and scored each nomination using a one to five scale with the ability to add an additional plus (+.25) or minus (-.25) to their score. Each nomination has a maximum possible score of 68.25 points, and the final score determines a nominations placement on the order of merit list for each medallion level.
