First Lesson 1 Samuel 24:8-15 8 Afterward David also arose and went out of the cave, and called after Saul, "My lord the king!" And when Saul looked behind him, David bowed with his face to the earth and paid homage. 9 And David said to Saul, "Why do you listen to the words of men who say, 'Behold, David seeks your harm'? 10 Behold, this day your eyes have seen how the Lord gave you today into my hand in the cave. And some told me to kill you, but I spared you. I said, 'I will not put out my hand against my lord, for he is the Lord's anointed. '11 See, my father, see the corner of your robe in my hand. For by the fact that I cut off the corner of your robe and did not kill you, you may know and see that there is no wrong or treason in my hands. I have not sinned against you, though you hunt my life to take it.12 May the Lord judge between me and you, may the Lord avenge me against you, but my hand shall not be against you.13 As the proverb of the ancients says, 'Out of the wicked comes wickedness.' But my hand shall not be against you.14 After whom has the king of Israel come out? After whom do you pursue? After a

dead dog! After a flea! 15 May the Lord therefore be judge and give sentence between me and you, and see to it and plead my cause and deliver me from your hand."

<u>Second Lesson</u> James 3:13-18 <u>13</u> Who is wise and understanding among you? By his good conduct let him show his works in the meekness of wisdom. <u>14</u> But if you have bitter jealousy and selfish ambition in your hearts, do not boast and be false to the truth. <u>15</u> This is not the wisdom that comes down from above, but is earthly, unspiritual, demonic. <u>16</u> For where jealousy and selfish ambition exist, there will be disorder and every vile practice. <u>17</u> But the wisdom from above is first pure, then peaceable, gentle, open to reason, full of mercy and good fruits, impartial and sincere. <u>18</u> And a harvest of righteousness is sown in peace by those who make peace.

Gospel Matthew 12:1-8 1 At that time Jesus went through the grainfields on the Sabbath. His disciples were hungry, and they began to pluck heads of grain and to eat. **2** But when the Pharisees saw it, they said to him, "Look, your disciples are doing what is not lawful to do on the Sabbath. "**3** He said to them, "Have you not read what David did when he was hungry, and those who were with him: 4 how he entered the house of God and ate the bread of the Presence, which it was not lawful for him to eat nor for those who were with him, but only for the priests? 5 Or have you not read in the Law how on the Sabbath the priests in the temple profane the Sabbath and are guiltless? 6 I tell you, something greater than the temple is here. 7 And if you had known what this means, 'I desire mercy, and not sacrifice, 'you would not have condemned the guiltless. 8 For the Son of Man is lord of the Sabbath."
