Chairman McDougald reported on an inquiry regarding availability of water at Cisco by parties involved in the proposed sodium silicate plant.

Chairman McDougald reported on the status of the work being done by the State and Corps of Engineers on the Mill Creek Dam. He indicated that a meeting would take place in Sacramento in the near future to attempt pushing the project along.

Director Norman reported that Marvin Jensen of the BLM had indicated that a delay to the project could be caused by the Reclamation Withdrawal which exists on the prject site. Mr. Jensen thought it may take two years or more of red tape in removing same. All agreed that this situation should again be reviewed with the BLM and Bureau of Reclamation.

Secretary Hoffman reported that Ken McKinney had returned the \$50.00 check for the water filing in Spanish Valley and had advised that to pursue the filing would be a waist of filing fee.

Secretary Hoffman reported that John Keogh had advised him that he would have the five (5) well locations West of Main Street in Moab by the end of the week.
