

PRIVACY POLICY

Welcome to IAAF. We have created this privacy policy in order to explain what information we gather from your visit to our web site and how such information may be used. Please also see our Terms of Use and Legal Disclaimer.

1. COLLECTION AND USE OF INFORMATION

As a general policy, does not request or collect personally identifiable information, such as your name, mailing address, or e-mail address on the web site. However, if you wish to obtain information about IAAF or to contact us through the web site, you will be asked to provide certain personal contact information in order to process your request. 3. SECURITY

4. USE OF COOKIES

Cookies are pieces of information that a web site transfers to an individual's computer hard drive for record keeping purposes. Cookies are not used by this web site but may be used on other sites accessible from our web site.

5. USE OF IP ADDRESSES

An IP address is a number that is automatically assigned to your computer by your internet provider whenever you are surfing the web. Whenever you request pages from our web site, our servers log your IP address. IAAF collects IP addresses for the purposes of its system administration and to analyze the use of its web site. We do not link IP addresses to any information that is personally identifiable, which means that your session will be logged, but you remain anonymous to us.
