



Resources Team

The Harpswell Aging at Home (HAH) Resources Team, comprised of volunteer social workers and nurses, makes home visits to each homeowner who has home repairs done by our Home Repairs Team. At the initial visit, they work with the homeowner to identify homeowners needs in areas of socialization; transportation; health and wellness, including falls and hospitalization; healthy food and nutrition; fire and safety; home maintenance; and chores. They recommend to the homeowner available resources to meet these needs. The Resources Team volunteers also provide needed help with obtaining available services in a variety of ways, including providing brochures or other descriptive and contact information, providing personal assistance with setting up needed contacts, and working with other volunteers to ensure the needed services are provided.

Following the initial visit, a three month follow-up is made to ensure homeowners have received the services they wanted and to determine if any new needs for resources have arisen.

In addition to visiting homeowners receiving home repairs from HAH, the team is also available to assist other Harpswell seniors in need of help with resources.
