**Over the Counter Medication  
For Your Child**

Covington Academy does not provide over the counter medication for student use. If you would like to have over the counter medication (ex: Ibuprofen, cough drops, allergy medication) available for your child, please provide medication in the original container placed inside a ziploc bag with your child's first and last name. Please include any specific instructions for medication on a notecard and place inside of ziploc bag. Medication must be dropped off at our front desk by a parent/guardian. Students will not be permitted to bring in their own medication. In the event that a student needs medication, he or she will be required to visit our front desk where medication will be held by CA personnel at all times.

**Additional Information**

- Each student will be given their own personal caddy for their daily in class supplies.
- If you want to bring more than a daily use of snacks or water for your student, a plastic bin is also provided in the classroom for each child. We recommend extra bottles of water to be stored in your student's snack bin at all times.
