

# The Preachers College

Article V of the Anabaptists Church Worldwide Articles of Faith require the Presiding Bishop to establish and administer a Preachers Training College for the teaching, educational discipline and preparing of Anabaptists preachers, ministers and teachers that are ordained for the work of the ministry throughout our national churches. Accordingly, the office of the Presiding Bishop is presently organizing and formatting the Anabaptists Preachers College which is scheduled to begin both its Kenya School, in Nairobi, Kenya and the Bunda Preachers College beginning in September 2017.

The Nairobi School already has approximately 36 young men interested in enrolling, many of which are National Security Policeman who regularly preach in the open air with the Presiding Bishop's Personal Attaché, who himself is a Special Investigator for the Kenya National Police stationed in Nairobi, Kenya and the National Evangelist for the Anabaptist Church of Kenya. The Nairobi College will operate in conjunction with the Bunda Preachers College, both of which will offer a combination of graduate and post graduate courses in Theology, Christian Ministry, Christian Education and Pastoral Studies. While the Nairobi College will be a full time class room curriculum for Kenya citizens on the Baccalaureate level only, the College in Bunda will be open to International Students, for both graduate and post graduate studies and will also incorporate required field research studies and field mission training opportunities within the Anabaptists Churches in Tanzania, Uganda, DR Congo, and the Islands of Lake Victoria.
