Junie is an 8-year-old red short-hair female with IVDD. She has been with her foster for 2 months and in that time has shown a lot of determination to use her back legs. She is sweet and loving and playful, but unfortunately she is incontinent and must have her bladder expressed 4-6 times a day. She willingly submits to this. Because of the paralysis in her back legs and her incontinence, Happy Tails had her evaluated for stem cell therapy and she was found to be a good candidate. She starts her preliminary testing next week. The therapy will take 4-6 weeks and she will also be undergoing water therapy and physical therapy during that time. Our hope is to improve her mobility and her continence issues. She loves kids and other dogs and does not have an aggressive bone in her body. She will be available for adoption after her stem cell therapy is completed.
