



Gilliam County Burn Ban in Effect

12:01am June 1, 2023

A burn ban on outdoor open burning will go into effect 12:01am June 1, 2023 by order of the Gilliam County Fire Chiefs under the authority of ORS 478.960

“Open Burning” includes burning garbage, debris, yard debris, construction materials, the remains of demolished structures, firewood in burn barrels, outdoor fireplaces, fire pits, and back yard incinerators.

Propane fire pits, cook stoves and barbeque grills with briquettes are allowed during the burn ban.

Agricultural burning is allowed provided the responsible party has fire suppression equipment available and on site and calls Frontier Regional 911 prior to burning. All agricultural fires must be extinguished by sunset.
