

Currituck Kids provides monetary grants through the County School System and the Department of Social Services to benefit children who would not otherwise receive assistance. Funds donated by Currituck Kids are not intended to replace gifts or donations provided by other organizations. Grants are targeted for emergency situations or situations not covered through other means or resources. Grants provided by Currituck Kids are intended to assist children with a short-term or one-time need. Examples include:

- Clothing
- Bedding
- Shoes
- Personal Hygiene Toiletries
- Prescribed Medicine
- Eyeglasses
- Food
- School Pictures

Some enrichment activities may also be considered a short-term or one-time need. When necessary, Currituck Kids has provided grants for the following educationally based activities:

- Sports
- Field Trips
- Musical Instruments
- Summer Camps
- Book Fairs

Grants have also been approved to support successfully established nonprofit programs. These include:

- Backpack for Kids – this program provides a pack of food for children to take home on Friday so they will have something to eat over the weekend
- One District, One Book – a district-wide project for elementary school students to improve literacy through reading at home with their family
- Scholarships – the Deborah C. Rorer Memorial Scholarship awarded to selected seniors
