CEMETERY INFO:

- ⇒ Flowers not in a container of a type specified in the Westmoreland City Cemetery Regulations shall be removed by the Cemetery Maintenance personnel or crew, June 10 or thereafter
- ⇒ Annual plantings in front of the tombstone are not allowed
- ⇒ Damaged or faded artificial flowers or wreaths may be removed by the Cemetery Supervisor as necessary to maintain the attractive, safe and neat appearance of the Cemetery. Any flowers on the ground will be discarded during mowing season (June 10th through October 31)
- ⇒ Lot owners are prohibited from placing on graves all toys, glass, chinaware, or other commemorative articles of any kind, with the exception that memorial markers from the armed services or nationally recognized clubs, shall be permitted. Prohibited articles so placed shall be removed and disposed of by the Cemetery Maintenance personnel or crew, without notice to the owner
