## 81st FRA and 79th FRA Auxiliary 2025 East Coast Regional Convention (ECRC)

This year's ECRC was held in Williamsburg, VA at the Fort Magruder Hotel and Conference Center and hosted by Branch/Unit 99 chaired by Shipmate JrPRPEC Gabriel Falu (Br. 99). Our Branch delegates Shipmates President PRPEC Randy Phillipp, PNC Paul Gunther, and RSEC Thomas Rauch were all in attendance.

On Wednesday, June 11, 2025 at 1300, Opening Ceremonies were held with the City of Virginia Beach Mayor Robert M. Dyer as the Keynote Speaker. Later that night there was a Welcome Aboard Party held with music and games.

On Thursday, June 12, 2025 at 0900 the FRA Business Session was called to order. Reports of the Regional Officers, President (Robert Oliveira), Vice President (Valerie Toulotte), Secretary (Thomas Rauch), Treasurer (Philip Stone) and Jr. PRPEC (Gabriel Falu) were read. The State and National Legislative Representatives from DE, VA, NC, and National Headquarters reported on Veteran programs and laws that pertained to their state or the Nation as a whole. There were no reports for MD and DC.

Next on the agenda were the Reports of the Standing Committees. This is where the results of the Regional Branches' submissions for the various committees were revealed. Our Branch in Group IV placed 1st for Americanism/Patriotism, Public Relations, and Youth Activities, 2nd for Hospitals, Welfare, Rehabilitation. For Veterans Service Officer and VA Voluntary Service, we had no report. Shipmates Gunther, Phillipp, Rauch and Kaider were selected as Shipmate of the Year for Americanism/Patriotism, Hospitals, Welfare, Rehabilitation, Public Relations and Youth Activities, respectively. The Budget & Finance and Audit Committees conducted their reports as well. Next was the Bylaws & Rules committee, which had no resolutions submitted this year.

The Time & Place committee reported that Branch 40 will host the 2026 Mid-Year Meeting (MYM), for the 2026 ECRC will be hosted by the ECR Red/Gray Hats Ad Hoc Committee. Then for 2027 the MYM will be hosted by Branch/Unit 99 and at the moment there is no host for the 2027 ECRC.

Under New Business there was one Branch that petition to operate under 1216(a) and was approved for ratification. Shipmate RTEC Stone motioned that the yearly assessment to be raise from \$.50 to \$1, which was seconded and approved after discussion. Then the 2025 2026 Elections of Regional Officers were held. Shipmate Ralph was an FRA Member of 25 years. Ralph joined the US Navy, where he served his country for 29 years. He retired in 1992 at the rank of Captain. Ralph saw combat action during the Vietnam war and was stationed all over the world during his illustrious career, including Japan, Korea, Guam and time stationed at the Pentagon. He had

several naval deployments, including as the Commanding Officer of the USS Flint, and even earned the honorary title of Commodore when he was the Commander of Maritime Expeditionary Security Squadron-3.
