The five members of 'N SYNC Justin Timberlake, Chris Joey Fatone. Kirkpatrick. Lansten Bass and JC Chasez have a little more in common than youth, charm and slick music industry packaging. Not only do the Orlando, Florida based band members share a passion for harmonious vocals, rhythmic dancing and dreams of stardom, they also ability to possess a natural create, record and perform great music.



Reflecting the perfect synchronization of five individual vocals, JustiN, ChriS, JoeY, LansteN and JC derived the band name by utilizing the last letter of each of their first names to spell 'N SYNC.

'N SYNC's universal bond of musical talent and creativity received international acclaim when '98 debut self-titled album sold over ten million copies and garnered four No. 1 singles, "I Want You Back," "Tearing Up My Heart," "God Must Have Spent A Little More Time On You," and "Drive Myself Crazy."

Even with a hectic touring schedule of over 300 concert dates in the last year, 'N SYNC still found the time to release Christmas EP, "Home For Christmas," and record a separate country version of "God Must Have Spent A Little More Time On You" with Alabama.

Other collaborations include a June 17, 2000 ABC network telecast of 'N SYNC and American Latina songstress, Gloria Estefan, receiving the prestigious ALMA (American Latino Media Arts) Special Achievement Award for "The Ten Outstanding Music Video Performers" with their hit video and single, "Music Of My Heart."

As they travel smoothly along the highway of musical success, 'N SYNC hit a bumpy detour in late '99 when they changed record labels and management. Legal issues escalated over the split, yet came to a quick and amicable conclusion for all parties concerned.

Signing with their new label, Jive Records, yielded the March released sophomore album, "No Strings Attached" and it's explosive debut single, "Bye Bye."

"We did the album independently," Chris explains. "A lot of the songs were written and produced in-house. We are so excited about this album!"

"No Strings Attached" reached No. 1 on the Billboard 200 chart, sold an amazing 3.76 million albums in it's first three weeks and shattered records as being the first album in history to sell more than 1 million albums in one day.

"It was a challenge doing this record," Justine admits. "Picking out the right songs that fit where you want to go musically and where you want to take your fans. We went through a lot of things in '99 and we went through them really fast."

The songs on "No Strings Attached" demonstrate 'N SYNC's wide musical range and capacity for artistic growth, renewal and redefinition.

"We have a very broad sound," Justin says. "There are some different directions we can take it, so we did as much of that as we could on this album. That's why we called the album 'No Strings Attached.' We have no strings to hold us down. We're ready to show the world that."

"No Strings Attached" exemplifies top hybrid songwriting in the pop-flavored Max Martin tunes, "Bye Bye Bye" and "It's Gonna Be Me," the lilting melodious Richard Marx ballad "This I Promise You," Diane Warren's emotional "That's When I'll Stop Loving You," and the cover of Johnny Kemp's '98 dance smash, "Just Got Paid."

"Everything on this album is well thought out and put together," JC says. "There were no half steps. Every knob was tweaked. Every button pushed to make this the best sounding album it could be. A lot of my dreams were fulfilled in this album. Richard Marx was one one of my idols growing up. The first song I ever sang in public was one of his."

The album also showcases JC's emergence as a songwriter and producer in the four hip hop influenced uptempo selections "Space Cowboy" (featuring TLC's Lisa "Left Eye" Lopes), "No Strings Attached," Bring In The Noise," and "Digital Getdown."

"The songs that I did like "No Strings Attached," the idea just hit me overnight," JC says. "Space Cowboy" was just a sign of the times, with all the Y2K bug going on and everyone screaming millennium this, millennium that. I came up with a song which asked the question, 'If the world ended tomorrow, what would we do?' We'd be cowboys in outer space, we'd be exploring new frontiers. "Digital Getdown" is also a sign of the times. Technology is everywhere and the internet is the thing to do. It's about people hopping on line and hooking up with each other. "Bring In The Noise" was about a basketball game, what it's like as a basketball player playing the game."

'N SYNC, along with tour mates Sisqo and Pink, kicked off a sold-out "No Strings Attached" stadium and arena national tour beginning May 9 in Biloxi, Mississippi, arriving in Joliet, Illinois on June 25 at the Route 66 Raceway and concluding July 30 in Hershey, Pennsylvania.

'N SYNC are also tentatively scheduled for a three-week European tour with label-mate, Britney Spears in October, which may lead to the possibility of a future collaboration with the pop diva.

In the meantime, the men of 'N SYNC will keep fans anxiously waiting in anticipation as they make preparations for the upcoming "No Strings Attached" second single and video release "It's Gonna Be Me."
