burritos for the group. After breakfast I am not sure what everyone did, but at 4pm everyone came back together for

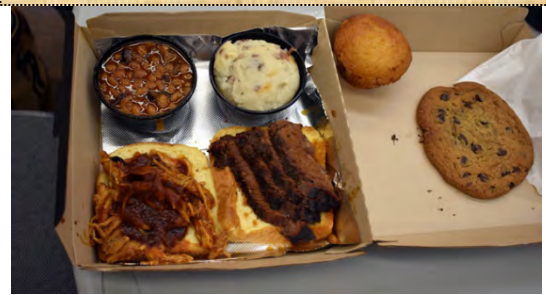


happy hour, about 5:15 the food showed up catered from Famous Dave's and picked up by David and Albert.
