Do You Still Remember? - Part 1 By Wade Anderson

Good morning, everyone! This morning as I sit here in my little 'Duck blind' on the front porch reading the Bible I'm in awe of all that's going on around me. First of all, I call this spot my 'Duck blind' because of the way that all the bushes and trees have grown up in front of me. From the sidewalk or for that matter even walking up to the front door you can't even see me sitting here until I say, "BOO!" "So," you ask, "What does all this have to do with the title of the article?"

Let's pray: "Gracious and Almighty heavenly Father I thank You for the eyesight that You've given me so that I see all of the beauty that surrounds me. I thank You for the air that I am breathing. I thank You for Your grace and Your mercy that I am not the same person I used to be before I allowed You to come into my life! I thank You for the simple things in my life today and that without You in my life I would have missed the true meaning for my life here on this Earth. I ask and invite Your Holy Spirit to be the teacher here today. And everything that is not truth according to Your Word let it be washed away in the precious blood of Jesus. AMEN! AMEN! "

I bet you all are thinking it's a little weird that I started out talking about this 'Duck blind' thing huh? Well, actually it's from this very place that I can look out across the front yard and remember so many different things and changes that have taken place in my life. So, let's just say I choose to view it all sort of like a monument. As I'm sitting here, I can hear the many different birds singing. It sounds like they all are having a party perched in the trees and bushes above me. It's almost like they know I just wrote that last sentence because all of a sudden they ALL began singing at the same time and their party just became louder.

Ten years ago, you would have never caught me in the front yard and especially NOT just sitting on the front porch reading a Bible. Back then I was very angry with the city to the point that it seemed like we were at war with each other. Because of the old lifestyle I was in, I ALWAYS had at least 6-8 motorcycles and somewhere between 2-6 vehicles parked on the front yard or on the street. This was exactly why the city and I were at war. They told me that I couldn't park all MY STUFF on the dirt; it had to be a 'dust free environment'. To this point I had even received a couple different summonses to comply from the city. Each of them was from \$2,000-\$5,000. "THIS IS MY HOUSE AND MY PROPERTY," I demanded, "AND YOU CAN'T TELL ME WHAT I CAN OR CAN'T DO ON IT!!" So, I obliged them and made the ENTIRE front area of our house a 'dust free environment'. I went and ordered 15 to 20 ton of gravel to be dumped across the whole front of our house. I guess I showed them. Huh? On top of this issue, as you all may also know, the city also has an ordinance or 'leash law' policy here in the city for our pets, right? Well, when I put that 9 1/2 foot tall, 17 foot long dinosaur sculpture on the gravel, in the front of our house, I knew I had to put it on a leash to keep them happy (smirk, smirk). So I put a long motorcycle tie down from its neck back to the eve of the house. After all the other stuff they were throwing tickets at me for, I sure didn't need any tickets for 'dinosaur at large'. Now that's funny right there!

Something else that comes to my remembrance as I sit here this morning is the fact that I very seldom went in the house through this front door. Being the self-centered individual that I was nearly everything I did revolved around me, motorcycles and my shop. Sure I loved my family and truthfully thought I was spending time with them, IF and when they came out to the shop to do it. And today I have to say 'OUCH' to that last sentence.

You may be thinking to yourselves, "Why is he, or should we for that matter, reflect and remember those things of the past?" It's a pretty simple answer actually. Looking back, reflecting and remembering my/our life before Christ and what and where our new walk with Him has taken us will reveal many, many great and wonderful things. Some of you may also be saying to yourselves, "Sure, it's all great and wonderful for you sitting there on your front porch, but I'm sitting here in a concrete cell surrounded by more concrete and razor wire!"

Sometimes in the middle of the storms it's hard to see, in the natural, that anything good is going to come out of the hard times. The Apostle Paul tells us, in 2 Corinthians 5:7, "For we live by faith, not by sight." Paul again, in Romans 4:16, "Therefore, the promise comes by faith, so that it may be by grace and may be guaranteed to ALL Abraham's offspring - not only to those who are of the law but also to those who have the faith of Abraham. He is the father of us all." You do know don't you that the 'ALL' Paul is referring to here is you and me!? That's why he said, "... also those who have the faith of Abraham." Notice Paul didn't say for us to have faith in Abraham but that our faith be like Abraham's, in God. Sure I'll agree that goodness and blessings may be hard to see at times. But that's simply because we've taken our eyes off of our Provider, our Promise Keeper, our Lord and Savior! I want to not only lift some of you but, hopefully, encourage you that when we do get our focus off the problem or situation and back on to God's promises like, "I will never leave you; never will I forsake you," (Hebrews 13:5, Deuteronomy 31:6-8) those things or situations will seemingly begin to dissolve and even look minimal in comparison to the Jesus that we serve! Let's move forward a few verses to Hebrews 13:6,8 where the author tells us, "So we say with confidence, 'The Lord is my helper; I will NOT be afraid. What can mere mortals do to me?' ... Jesus Christ is the SAME yesterday and today and FOREVER." Here's another powerful promise to remember, in 1 John 4:4, "You, dear children, are from God and have overcome

them, because the One who is in you is greater than the one who is in the world." I know that in context John is speaking about false teachers. But think about this for just a second. When tough times come our way we have got to remember that because of the finished work of Christ we ARE ALREADY OVERCOMERS that He is in you and you are in Him, that there are NO weapons formed against us that will ever prosper! It's when we remember and stand firm on God's promises that we find His rest in the midst of even the storms of life.

One of the reasons we would get in a funk is because we've taken our eyes off of the One who NEVER fails us. In Deuteronomy 31:6, as Moses was commissioning or passing on the leadership to Joshua he encouraged Joshua with these words. "Be strong and courageous. Do not be afraid or terrified because of them, for the LORD your God goes with you; He will NEVER leave you nor forsake you." We have to go further back in Scripture, to Exodus 3, where Moses had his encounter with the LORD, through a burning bush, and where God soon introduced Himself as the great "/ AM WHO I AM." It was right there, in Exodus 3, that Moses was given the commission to lead God's people, the Israelites, out of Egypt. In Exodus 3:7-8,10,12, the LORD spoke to Moses and said, "I have indeed seen the misery of My people in Egypt. I have heard them crying out because of their slave drivers, and I am concerned about their suffering. So I have come down to rescue them from the land of the Egyptians and to bring them up out of that land into a good and spacious land, a land flowing with milk and honey ... So now, go. I am sending you to Pharaoh to bring My people the Israelites out of Egypt ... I will be with you." Here is yet another picture of God's grace and mercy for His people. Not just the Israelites but for us as well. People, God just stated that He seen their misery and heard them crying out. We just read, in Hebrews 13:8 that, "Jesus Christ is the SAME yesterday and today AND FOREVER." Seeing that He is the same God/Jesus wouldn't you think and even more so, use the faith you do have and BELIEVE that He sees your pain and hears your prayers as well? Of course He does! Okay, I heard a few of you but that wasn't a very strong AMEN from the rest of you.

God said it was a good and spacious land that they could call their own. God first called Moses and then He sent him. Was it God's fault that it took them 40 years to reach that Promised Land? No! It was while they were in this process, which by the way is exactly where most of us slip and fail to remember God's faithfulness, in the process. Under Moses' leadership the people began to gripe and moan saying, "Why is God doing this to us? Why has He taken us out from where we were (even though they were slaves for 430 years there) and led us into the desert to die?" Now let me ask all of you, does any of this sound familiar? While you're in the 'process' does your faith begin to fall short? Do you seem to focus more on the issue at hand rather than focusing on God's promises? Well don't feel like the Lone Stranger, it happens to all of us. The key here is to sooner rather than later recognize what has happened and GET BACK UP!

How soon they had forgotten! God had just sent 10 plaques (*Exodus* 7-11) against the Egyptian people to cause them to release His people, the Israelites. It was at the 10th plaque, the death of every first born male human and first born male animal of their flocks, that God finally got their undivided attention. God told Moses and Aaron, *"I will bring one more plaque on Pharaoh and on Egypt. After that, he WILL let you go from here, and when he does, he will drive you out completely. Tell the people that men and women alike are to ask their neighbors for articles of silver and gold." (Exodus 11:1-2)*

God knew what He was about to do would not only bring the Egyptians to their knees, but also cause the Israelites to always reflect and remember what God had done that night. God gave specific instructions to Moses and Aaron of what He wanted His people to do. The instructions were for each Israelite family represented that they were to take a one-year old, male sheep or goat, spotless and without defect and slaughter it at twilight, "Then take some of the blood and put it on the sides and tops of the doorframes of the houses where they eat the lambs." (Exodus 12:7) God gave them specific ways to cook these lambs, how much to eat, "Do not leave any of it until morning; if some is left till morning, you must burn it" and exactly what to wear while they were eating it. The final instruction was to "Eat it in haste, it is the LORD'S Passover." (Exodus 12:8-11) This last plague would mark and come to be remembered and known as the Passover celebration, which also marked the Israelites freedom from exactly 430 years of slavery. The Israelites placing the lamb's blood on their doorposts paints a picture of the Cross and the spotless Lamb (Jesus) that God provided for us when He sacrificed His Son and shed His blood on the Cross at Calvary.

By Exodus 12:31, we see that Pharaoh finally had enough. He called for Moses and Aaron and said, "Up! Leave my people, you and the Israelites! Go, worship the LORD as you have requested. Take your flocks and herds, as you have said, and go." The Egyptians had witnessed lots of crazy things going on around them throughout these other nine plaques. But it was during this last plaque that they became terrified and urged the Israelites to hurry and get out of there, "For otherwise we will die!" (Exodus 12:33) The Israelites had just watched with their very own eyes as God freed them from the clutches and stubborn leadership of Pharaoh. This is also a picture for us as well of being rescued and set free from the world and sin through Salvation, IN CHRIST. Not only were they set free but they were given favor and told to ask, "The Egyptians for articles of silver and gold and for clothing. The LORD had made the Egyptians favor-ably disposed towards the people, AND THEY GAVE THEM WHAT THEY ASKED FOR; so they plundered the

Hello my Overcomers for Officiet family! Let me begin with these three questions. 1) Does the life I'm living glorify God? 2) Do I sin intentionally? 3) If I was on trial for being a 'Christian' would there be enough evidence to convict me? A brother in Christ brought me a book of Andrew Wommack's that brought these questions to my attention, THANK YOU!

I know that straddling the fence or being 'lukewarm' won't cut it. So I asked myself, "Can others see Christ in me?" Just going through the motions will NOT save me, or you. Then I asked myself, "Would I have nailed Jesus to that Cross?" We'd all like to say NO!!! But if we keep on sinning, intentionally, after ALL that Jesus has already done for us, we're not only nailing Him to that Cross, but in a sense, we're also spitting in His face while He is hanging there.

Right now I'm sitting in the county jail and I thank God for the Overcounces for Oficiet. When I moved to a new cell I found one of their newsletters laying in that cell. So I decided to write and see if I could be added to the mailing list.

Sometimes it only takes a spark to get a fire going in us. ALL of us need help and encouragement to grow deeper in our faith and send our roots deep into the soil of God's grace. Amen? We must never forget what Jesus told us in *Matthew* 4:4, "Man shall not live on bread alone, but on EVERY word that comes from the month of God." If we don't read the Bible AND follow what it tells us our fire will eventually die out.

Here's another 'real' question I've asked myself. Do others want what I have? And now back to the big question I mentioned in the beginning. "If I was on trial for being a 'Christian' would there be enough evidence to convict me?" Today, I ask the Lord to help me have the fruit in my life that would produce the evidence to find me guilty of being a 'Christian'!

Just wanted to give a shout out to say, THANK YOU! Sometimes we have to refocus and take a step back to really look at our walk. Let me encourage everyone as I encourage myself, "Walk by faith not by sight, stay in the Spirit and we won't live in the flesh! God NEVER gives up on us so we shouldn't turn our backs on Him!" Don't ever forget this promise God gave us, in *Jeremiah 33:3, "Call to Me and I WILL answer you and tell you great and unsearchable things you do not know."* Keep us in your prayers and I'll do the same for all of you!

Foot's Bible Study Rotes

2 Chronicles 19:1-20:37

God holds us accountable for the authority we exercise. (19:5-10)

As the enemy bore down on Judah, God spoke through Jahaziel, "Don't be afraid ... for the battle is not yours, but God's." We may not fight an enemy army, but every day we battle temptation, pressure, and rulers of the unseen world who want us to rebel against God. (*Ephesians 6:12*) Remember as believers, we have God's Spirit in us. If we ask for God's help when we face struggles, God will fight for us, and God always triumphs. (20:15)

Romans 9:25-11:12

Paul explains that God's plan is not for those who try to earn His favor by being good; it is for those who realize they can never be good enough and so must depend on Christ. We can be saved only by putting faith in what Jesus Christ has done. If we do that, we will never be disappointed. (9:31-33)

If we believe in our heart and say with our mouth that Christ is the risen Lord, we will be saved. (10:8-12) For anyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved. (10:13) We must take God's great message of Salvation to others so that they can respond to the Good News. How will your loved ones and neighbors hear it unless someone tells them? Is God calling you to take part in making His message known in the community? Think of one person who needs to hear the Good News, and think of something you can do to help him or her hear it. Then take that step as soon as possible. (10:14-15)

We are saved through faith in Christ, not because we are part of a nation, religion, or family. On whom or on what are you depending for Salvation? (11:2)

Psalm 20:1-21:13

As long as there have been armies and weapons, nations have boasted of their powers, but such power does not last. Throughout history, empires and kingdoms have risen to great power only to vanish in the dust. David, however, knew that the true might of his nation was not in weaponry but in worship, not in firepower but in God's power. Because God alone can preserve a nation or an individual, be sure your confidence is in God, who gives eternal victory. Whom do you trust? (20:6-8)

If you aspire to leadership, keep the Lord God at the center of your life and depend on Him. His wisdom is the best strength you can have. (21:7) When we trust in God, we have permanence and stability. We may lose a great deal - families, jobs, material possessions - but we cannot be shaken from God's favor. He will be our foundation of solid rock. He will never leave or desert us. (21:7)

Proverbs 20:2-6

A person who is truly confident of his or her strength does not need to parade it. A truly brave person does not look for chances to prove it. A resourceful man can find a way out of a fight. A man of endurance will avoid retaliating. Foolish people find it impossible to avoid strife, men and women of character can. What kind of person are you?

You've heard similar warnings, if you don't study you will fail the test, if you don't save, you won't have money when you need it. God wants us to anticipate future needs and prepare for them. We can't expect Him to come to our rescue when we cause our own problems through lack of planning and action. He provides for us, but He also expects us to be responsible. (20:4)

Egyptians." (Exodus 12:35-36) I encourage you all to read further on in this story. Invite the Holy Spirit to enlighten you to the types and shadows there of the Christ to come. I'm learning over time and through the Scriptures that it is important to stop for a few minutes every day and remember where and what God has reached down and brought me 'out of'. It's equally as important to praise God and thank Him for all that He has ALREADY done in our lives to date. People, this shouldn't be that hard! If you woke up this morning you have something to praise God for! If you were then able to throw your legs over the edge of your rack you have something to praise God for! Believe me, there are millions of people out here on the streets that are in worse prisons and bondage than you are right where you may be sitting today. It's the people that have either never heard of or refuse to acknowledge that praise, honor and thankfulness to God that entangles them in bondage, a prison within themselves. These are the people that remain locked up and unable to find true peace.

With that we'll pick back up right here next month in Acts 16.

The phrase THIS IS A CRYPTOGRAM might turn into the encrypted phrase FKDR DR U BAZOFMIAUC. In this cryptogram you can see that throughout the phrase the letter "T" has been replaced by the letter "F, the letter "A" has been substituted with "U", and so on.

Here are a few tips to get you going:

- · A letter can never be substituted with itself.
- · The only (well...by far the most common) single letter words are "A" and "I".
- · Look for common letter combinations, like "TH" and "SH".
- · The word "THE" is the most common three letter word.
- · Watch for the pattern "XCBX". This is usually the word "THAT".
- · All words generally have at least one vowel.

One thing I do know, I understand that there is no prison so secure, no walls so high, no pit so deep, no soul so lost, and no heart so cold that God's love cannot penetrate. There are some things that man cannot place chains upon and that cannot be confined to prison. God's Spirit and His Love cannot be bound, even in chains. I'm still bound in physical chains and I'm still in prison, but there are some people who are more bound than I will ever be. There are many kinds of prisons, and sometimes we are our own jailers.

I can confidently say that Jesus can set us free. For the first time in my life, I feel free. I have a peace that can only come from truly knowing that I am saved. Only by God's grace and mercy I'm alive today. I faced death many times throughout my life, and surely should have died, but the Lord spared my life. He has given me a new life. If He can show someone like me love and mercy, then there is hope for everyone. If God's love can reach into the darkness of my heart and my world and change my life, then there is hope for everyone. The Lord has broken the chains of compassion and love for others, Amen! The God we serve is an all powerful, miracle working God. He changes lives, and He changes people's hearts. I stand here today as proof of that. I wrote this while in lockdown in prison. I feel very confident that these few faithful words will touch you because the Holy Spirit has inspired my heart to release it to you. It's amazing how far we've come to recognize Who we serve. - **R.V.**
