Annual Supply Fee

I wanted to remind everyone that September 2nd, I will be billing for the Annual Supply Fee. This is \$100 per family even if you are on coalition. The only exception to this is VPK only families as we are not allowed to charge them anything according to the state.

If you are automatic withdrawal, I will not take the money from your account until Friday, September 27th. I am doing this on a Friday so that you can clearly see it separate from your normal billing. You are always welcome to pay for this ahead of time by utilizing a debit/credit card or cash. This fee must be paid by everyone by September 30th.

September 2nd - Annual supply fee billing. This is \$100 per family per year.


