



Allison Dale "A.D." Rapson, age 89, of Colfax Township, passed away peacefully on January 7, 2017 at Rose Garden Senior Living in Pigeon.

Dale was born in Centerline, Michigan on June 19, 1927 to the late Earl T. and Dessalee (Stickle) Rapson.
