

January 2023 ABATE of Oklahoma State Board Meeting

Call to Order January 14, 2023 12:02

Prayer Requests- Quentin Dunn, Steve Stewart, Jukebox, Misty, Kim Haines, Richard Beale.

All Chapters present.

Approval of November and December Meeting minutes- Waived due to minutes not being provided to members as required by by-laws.

Discussion regarding lack of timely distribution of minutes, A motion was made to vacate the office of Secretary, held by Tammy Johnson, due to dereliction of duty. A second was made. Roll call vote, Unanimous, motion carries.

Motion made to hold nominations open for secretary until February board meeting and for voting to occur at same time. Unanimous. Motion carries.

Financial Report- November and December reports were combined. Checking balance is \$26,204.70. Savings balance is \$24,929.87. Proposed 2023 budget was distributed. Board members are asked to provide proposed budget to chapters and return ready to vote at March general membership meeting. Motion to approve financial Report. Second. Roll call vote, motion unanimously carries.

Membership Report- Paper report with statistics given to chapter reps. At the end of 2022, ABATE of Oklahoma had 649 members. This is an increase from 624 at the beginning of the year. Motion made to accept membership report as written. Second. Roll call vote, motion carried unanimously.

Governmental Affairs- Thank you to James Chambers Clark for working on anti-profiling bill with Senator Dahm. Discussion of whether SB83 was introduced on our behalf or on behalf of another organization. Until that is known, ABATE of Oklahoma will not make a stand. As it is now, the bill stays the same as it has in previous years and is unlikely to pass with the requirements on law enforcement. Rep. Luttrell has put forward the bill removing the handlebar height requirement again this year. Legislative Day is scheduled for March 8 at 8 am. Motion to accept report was made and seconded. Roll Call vote, motion carried unanimously.

Merchandise Report- In October we tabled a motion for merchandise to have a larger budget. Sold \$806 of merchandise at Tulsa Toy Run and could have sold more if they had more to sell. There is very little merchandise remaining. A motion and second was made for \$5000 to be put in a revolving fund in the budget for purchasing merchandise. Roll Call vote, motion carries unanimously.

Safety Report- Fluctuating temps mean that you need to check your tire pressure often. Look out for potholes and wildlife in the road. Watch your speed in construction areas, as there are often things that are dangerous for motorcycles.

MRF Report- In the last month of 2022 the MRF had several victories. A letter was sent to committee about autonomous vehicles not recognizing motorcycles. NHTSA directed to report what they are encouraging states to do to appropriation committee. Motorcycle anti-profiling bill passed. Upcoming events include Bikers in the Beltway in May and Meeting of the Minds in September. JP Memorial scholarship fund is there to assist with funding.

Share The Road- Steve went to an OHSO meeting and spoke with director about next years grant funding but his contact has since stopped communication. He did learn very late about prequalification for next year's grant request and did get it in by the tight deadline. Should have an answer by the 17th, but it isn't looking great. Still have outstanding questions about ownership of Share the Road equipment. We have now been fully reimbursed for all previous claims.

SMILE- Breakout sessions will include officer trainings. March 3,4,5. Preregistration is now open until March 1st. Guest speaker will be Eric Ross from the MRF and Garry is working on another one. Friday night is going to be different this year, more of a brainstorming session. Make your reservations now, room rate is \$109 per night. Don't forget Centerpieces and auction items.

Voting was held for life member by board. The winner of the board vote will need a super majority of current board members and past life members.

Ride to Remember- Heartland needs volunteers, approx.. 8-10 people to help with stops and merchandise. 2nd weekend in April.

River Run- We will be able to hold the river run at Eagle Bluff Resort. Working on finalizing that and making a flyer.

Biker Breakfast- Chapters asked to volunteer to provide the biker breakfast and schedule months.

Court Watch- Bench Trial began in State v Cerna, 2nd day will be April 2nd. State v Cabral we need people to sign the [change.org](https://www.change.org) petition in attempt to pressure the Oklahoma County District Attorney to file more charges in this death. Please attend any hearing you can.

Call to Order February 11, 2023

Prayer Requests were made.

All Chapters present with the exception of Osage Hills and Southwest.

January Meeting minutes were approved as written.

Governmental Affairs Legislative Day, March 8th 2023 was discussed. Donuts will be picked up by Lotus. Brook will be picking up the coffee. Garry will be providing talking points to be discussed during legislative day. Garry will also provide the details soon on a hotel where they will be staying the night before to discuss talking points. Meeting site to ride to the capital as a group will also be provided at a later date. Todd with Law Tigers was present to give input and discussion on possible bills that may affect motorcyclists. He also said to check your insurance policies to insure you have uninsured motorist, to protect yourself and you help pay any of "your medical bills." Motion made to approve Governmental Affairs by Heartland, Second by Lakes Area. Roll call vote, motion unanimously carries.

Financial Report- January Checking balance is \$25,894.95. Savings balance is \$24,929.87. It was requested that the Childhood hunger donation needs to be checked on to see when they needs to be written. Proposed 2023 budget was distributed. Board members came back to this meeting with the following proposals for change to the budget. Increase the merchandise operating budget. Add the Spring Fling Campout back into the budget. Increase the MRF Scholarship Fund. Take back to your chapters and return ready to vote at the March general membership meeting. Motion to approve financial Report by NW69. Second by Heartland. Roll call vote, motion unanimously carries.

Membership Report- ABATE of Oklahoma had 663 members as of 1/31/23. Shawna spoke to AIL Insurance. They are trying to increase our payout to \$4,000.00 versus the current \$3,500.00. That increase is based on the return of the yellow cards they send out to everyone. Those need to be mailed back into AIL in order to get a better percentage. Motion made to accept membership report . Second. Roll call vote, motion carried unanimously. Motion to approve Membership Report by Chisholm Trail 412. Second by Heartland. Roll call vote, motion unanimously carries.

MRF Report- Art said the Capital Building is now open to make appointments and go with your legislators. Upcoming events include Bikers in the Beltway, May 15th and 16th in Washington DC. MRF Scholarships are available to help fund those wanting to attend. Meeting of the Minds is

September 21st – 24th in Harrisburg, PA for details to follow and MRF Scholarships are also available for this event. Garry put out a challenge for all Chapter Presidents and Officers to attend this event. Motion to approve MRF Report by Heartland. Second by Tulsa. Roll call vote, motion unanimously carries.

Safety Report- Fluctuating temps mean that you need to check your tire pressure often. Look out for potholes and wildlife in the road. With the temps being very cold watch for signs of hypothermia. DOT is putting down sand and salt for the ice, beware of those items on the road.

Merchandise Report- Shawna reported that the SMILE shirts have been ordered. She has also ordered 50 back patches. Motion to approve Merchandise Report by NW69. Second by Heartland. Roll call vote, motion unanimously carries.

Old Business – Chapters were asked for State Secretary nominations. Connie Mayberry was nominated. Connie is willing to try it for three months and see if you are happy with how she does it. If you are happy with her, she will continue out the term. Motion to approve Old Business by NW69. Second by Heartland. Roll call vote, motion unanimously carries.

New Business – Lotus proposed making a Court Watch Facebook page. Garry stated it should be posted on the ABATE of Oklahoma facebook page. After discussion it was decided to allow the Court Watch Facebook with information being posted on both sites as to not be missed. Motion to approve New Business by Chisholm Trail 412. Second by Tulsa. Roll call vote, motion unanimously carries.

Share The Road- Steve announced we did get approved for the prequalification round for the 2024 grant. He is asking for assistance from Lotus and Garry to help meet the deadline of February 24, 2023 to submit the next round of paperwork to OSHO. We have been contacted by Oklahoma Challenge requesting dates that we can do seminars. Funding would be requested by the chapters to help fulfill those requests since we have no grant for the 2023 to reimburse members, but feel we still need to provide that education.

SMILE- March 3,4,5. Preregistration is now open for \$30.00, after March 1st the fee is \$35.00. Make your reservations, the room block is full. However; Debbie has been told that they may honor that rate if you call the reservations line. Don't forget Centerpieces and auction items.

River Run – Will be July 13-16 at Eagle Bluff Resort again. The flyer is under construction but will be out soon.

Flag Salute: Pledge of Allegiance

Roll Call: All chapters present.

Steve Stewart welcomed all members and the MRF spokesmen. Steve thanked everyone for being a part of this ABATE organization. Steve introduced Connie Maberry as the new State Secretary.

February MINUTES: Minutes were approved with the correction of Connie Maberry's last name.

FINANCIAL REPORT: February 2023 Sam Trevino

Income: Total Income **\$1,980.00.**

Expense: Total Expense **\$1,484.07.**

Checking Account: **\$20,662.17**

Savings Account: **\$24,929.87.**

2 CD's with \$2,500.00 each. One redeemable July 2023 and the other January 2024.

Osage Hills made the motion to accept the financial report as presented, second by Heartland. Roll call vote, all agreed, motion carried.

2023 Budget Review: Discussion was made to make merchandise a \$5,000.00 revolving operating budget.

Suggestion to replace the members only poker run budget of \$500.00 with a 2023 spring fling family camping trip of a \$500.00 budget.

Suggestion to change the Smile budget to \$6,000.00.

Suggestion to raise MRF budget. Garry suggested revisiting this at another time, use the \$3,000.00 to send members to Bikers in the Beltway. Then come back later to request more money for Meeting of the minds. The decision was made to leave it as it is.

Balanced budget of **\$51,200.00** income and expense.

Suggestion to raise Smile to \$6,000.00. NW 69 made the motion except the proposed 2023 budget with the Smile increase to \$6,000.00. Heartland second. Roll call vote, all agreed, motion carried.

Membership Report: Shawna Scholten on 02-28-23 we had 663 members. As of 2-28-23 member total is 680. Next month, we start the 300 free memberships.

AIL will be sent out soon. If you have no changes to your beneficiary card just sign and mail it back. Next year they are working on our insurance possibly going from \$3,500.00 to \$4,000.00. Heartland made the motion to except membership report, second by Tulsa. Roll call vote, all agreed, motion carried.

Governmental Affairs: Garry Cannady, Legislative day is this Wednesday. Last week Garry handed out invitations to attend Legislative day to our congressmen. We have 2 bills that we have asked sponsors to take care of. HB1076 is Handlebar height bill and HB2426 motorcycle profiling. A discussion was had on where to meet, what would happen when they got there and how to act by Garry. Osage made the motion to accept Governmental affairs report, second by Lakes Area. Roll call vote, all agreed, motion carried.

Merchandise Report: Shawna Scholten, In February \$360.00 from sale of merchandise. Shawna went over ordered items. Shawna requested to go back to members to see if anyone knows someone that could make gremlin bells with ABATE on it. Suggestion was made to make a patch with the two eyes on it. Heartland made the motion to accept the Merchandise Report, second by Osage, roll call vote, all agreed, motion carried.

Safety Report: Art – discussion on potholes. Tulsa had two fatalities last week caused by potholes. Art encouraged everyone to call ODOT to repair potholes in your area. In Tulsa call 311 to report potholes.

MRF Report: This meeting is tabled until this evening's banquet.

Old Business:

Rob, Garry & Spook - new committee for events. A booth will be set up at Sparks June 12th – 18th for Bike Week. The committee discussed having our Freedom Fighter Rally while they were having their big rally. They would give us a few free passes and a spot for our booth. But to get discounts for getting in, we would need to give them \$1,000.00 to \$1,500.00. Then we could get in for \$20.00 instead of \$60.00. A discussion was had. Steve suggested for the committee to get back with Robert to see if they would be interested in ABATE being a sponsor for the Halloween Bash. Partnering with someone would give us more opportunities and possible new memberships. Rob will get back with Robert to see what he can negotiate for the Halloween Bash and bring it back to the Board.

Q introduced Shawn, President of OKC Down Bikers. They have a booth set up at Sparks St. Patrick's Day on March 17th. They will give ABATE of Oklahoma a booth to set up a table for recruitment and 3 passes. Q discussed some opportunities we could have with Down Bikers co-sponsoring events and split the proceeds. Shawn stated when he has a meeting with all his presidents, he will bring it up to them to become ABATE members.

Court Watch: Lotus Dunn the Court Watch Facebook page is not set up but will be soon. Lotus went over the new and old cases. Be sure to contact the representatives regarding the court watches.

Steve Stewart discussed Oklahoma Biker magazine having an ad stating Court Watch Oklahoma ABATE. It needs to say ABATE of Oklahoma Court Watch. A discussion was had on how that information got there. Decision was made to change all phone numbers to the ABATE of Oklahoma toll free number.

River Run: The Gus Johnson Memorial was not put on the River Run T-shirts on accident. Anita will address the issue. There might be some hurt feelings. An updated flyer is being sent out and is on the Facebook page. Anita/412 is the host of the event. Lindsey/Osage Hills has requested a text sent out to announce the event and the help needed. This is our Legislative fundraiser, every cent made goes to our Legislative budget. Because of the cost of this event a day pass will not be allowed.

New Business: Lotus suggested we have approx. \$75,000.00 could we spend some money for motorcycle safety month by putting up some billboards or other items. Steve stated get some estimates and ideas, present to the Board next month.

OHSO: Steve completed the grant process for \$38,800.00. Mike Bray was his contact. He gave no guarantees and no idea of a time frame. A discussion was had on the trailer. We will continue using it until it falls apart. A discussion was had regarding the storing of the trailer. Suggestion, put a topper on the back of the pickup for security and wouldn't need the trailer. Q has a friend that deals with toppers & will contact him and report back. 2021 they ran 3200 students through the program, 2022 3600 students, they are hoping to increase another 250 for 2023. A discussion on how OSHO spends the money.

Share The Road: April with Oklahoma Teen Challenge has been in contact with Steve wanting the Share the Road program. Steve will be contacting each chapter President to get someone trained from their chapter.

DBA Report: Q suggested everyone download the DBA app to see what's going on.

Q – Chapter Presidents will receive email from Richard Grisham with Island newsletter requesting pictures from each chapter for his biker newsletter.

Steve's Challenge – Go to every event if you can, by getting out and visiting your chapters, support each other.

Governmental Affairs- Report given by Garry. Had a great legislative day. Be prepared for Call to Action on the Handlebar Height bill in Senate committee. HB 2426- Anti-Profiling Bill struggled but passed the House. Now to Senate committee. Was assigned to the Public Safety committee. Need legislative ideas for next year. Call to Order May 13, 2023 at 12:00 Noon

Prayer Request: Rita Browns family. Picture Man's Grandson was killed - pray for the family, including Lotus & Quentin Dunn. Christy Pool's cancer is back. Kimberly Terry's heart is only working on 20%.

Flag Salute:

Roll Call: Southwest chapter was not present.

Mission Statement: Read by Steve Stewart.

Introductions and Welcomes: Steve Stewart welcomed back Bob & Kim Mobley visiting from Mississippi.

State Coordinator Steve Stewart welcomed everyone. Steve spoke about 3 fatalities last week in Oklahoma City. There will be no July meeting since everyone will be at the river run.

March Minutes: NW 69 made the motion to accept the March minutes, second by Osage Hills, motion carried.

April Minutes: Osage Hills made the motion to accept the April minutes, second by NW69, motion carried.

Financial Report: As of 4.30.23 checking balance is \$26,161.68, savings account \$24,945.24, 2 CD's which total \$25,000.00 with one redeemable 7.20.23 and the other redeemable 1.20.24. Motion to approve financial report by NW69, second by Chisholm Trail 412. Motion carried.

Merchandise Report: As of 4.1.23 we had 709 members, on 4.30.23 we had 725 Members. Osage Hills made the motion to accept the Merchandise report, Chisholm Trail 412 second, motion passed.

Mailbox in OKC: Shawna has one key to our Oklahoma City mailbox and Brook has the second key. Shawna checked the mailbox it had 3 months of mail. The oldest piece was dated March 3. Garry Canady will oversee moving our Oklahoma City mailbox to Stillwater.

Governmental Affairs: Report given by Garry. June 2 - 4 is our FREE ABATE Campout. ABATE will reimburse everyone for any park fees. Garry stated he has failed on our bills. Garry gave an explanation in football terms as to how bills are worked. Steve Stewart stated, the bills coming out of the house are not going to

the Senate. The handlebar bill didn't make it to the floor. Osage Hills made the motion to except the Government Affairs report, second by Tulsa Chapter, motion passed.

Legislation: Kim Mobley stated only one bill will show up next session. The legislation session will close next week until it resumes in August. Kim watched 15 bills all year. Eight bills did not get heard in committee, so they must be reapplied. Kim explained the remainder of the bills including anti-profiling. Kim believes we need to continue with Handsfree bill and HB2130 the child support payment bill, and the fossil fuel bill.

Garry lost the banner he had for advertising. Osage Hills made the motion to spend up to \$400 to purchase a new banner for advertising, second by Tulsa Chapter, motion passed.

Steve Stewart thanked Kim for doing the Legislative work. July 1st her contract is up for \$9,000.00. Please take this back to your chapters to discuss and we will vote next month. Garry requests a change to the contract to include a performance-based increase. Example a bill passes giver her an increase. Steve Stewart again stated, go back to your chapter, as long as the chapters agree we can do this. This will be voted on. If you have any questions call Steve Stewart or Garry Canady.

Merchandise Report – by Shawna. The report is the same as last month. We will be putting in an order for the gremlin bells. Osage Hills made the motion to accept the merchandise report, second by Lakes Area.

Safety Report: By Garry Cannady. Don't get drunk and drive your motorcycle. Do not do this!

MRF Report: By Frenchie. There are a couple of pictures in the MRF journal of our members. Ray Fitzgerald passed away.

Old Business:

Spring campout is June 2-4 at Sparks America Campground.

Sparks Bike Rally is October 19-23. \$3,000.00 fee offer, ABATE will pay with booth and \$25 per ABATE member to get into rally. NW69 made the motion, Osage Hills second, motion passed.

River Run – Anita has been sick. The new flyer has Gus Johnson Memorial on it. No RV hookups. We need auction items.

Pricing on Advertisement/PR will be struck from our agenda because of non-movement.

New Business:

Osage Hills requested a bylaws change to include someone who will read and we review parts of the by-laws. And to do a different section every month. Steve Stewart stated he would do this and get it implemented next month.

Kicking Childhood Hunger, Garry stated it is time to send a check in and he would deliver it.

OHSO/Share the Road: Steve Stewart received an email saying we have been pre-selected to receive a grant. He requested \$38,000.00. A case worker will be getting in contact with him. This money is part of Charitable Services. A brief discussion was had about becoming a 501c3 and getting legal advice.

Court Watch: A discussion was had on how Court Watch started by Garry. Carla Davis wants to help with this committee. She lost her son to a motorcycle wreck. Lindsay stated we need to get in contact with the District Attorney's Council.

DBA Report: Gary discussed how ABATE got started with DBA. DBA gave ABATE of Oklahoma a check for \$10,000.00 but ABATE never thanked them.
