OCTOBER TOURNAMENTS



The October tournaments were scheduled for October 8th on Hamilton and October 23rd a wildcard. Best producing baits were a green pumpkin trick worm on a jig head, Carolina rig (lower left) Other baits that were successful included a darter head jig with a salt and pepper dead ringer, top water, drop shot and Alabama rig.

The top three anglers for the October Hamilton tournament were: Kirk Bixler with 140 ounces, Dave Keith with 119 ounces and Ron Knight with 107 ounces. On the co-angler side the top three were: Paul Galfund with 137 ounces, Ernie Infusino with 85 ounces and Sue Duvall with 81 ounces.

Big bass on the Angler side went to Kirk Bixler with 34 ounces. Big bass on the co-angler side went to Dan Retzer with 48 ounces.

The top three anglers for the October Wildcard tournament were: Dave Keith with 142 ounces, Greg Osterhout with 121 ounces and Darrell Graham with 100 ounces. On the co-angler side the top three were: Pete DeVries with 124 ounces, Norm Faustlin with 82 ounces and Mike Ray with 58 ounces.
