Boat Slip and Kayak Rental Space Now Available at the CBTB Dock

Is it a hassle to get your kayak to the water every time you want to take it out? If so, we now have a solution for you . . . a kayak rack at the dock. For \$20 a year, property owners in good standing can keep their kayaks right next to the water and easily get in and out at the boat ramp. Just supply your own cable and lock. If interested, go to <u>www.corrotomanbythebay.org</u> and complete the Kayak Rental Application and send it to Rivers Accounting with your check. All the information is on the application.

Boat slip rental is again \$150 for the year. If intested, please send your \$150 check, the completed application

(available at <u>www.corrotomanbythebay.org</u>), and proof of insurance to Rivers Accounting, P. O. Box 406, White Stone, VA 22578. Boat slips and kayak space are rented on a first come, first serve basis. For a key to gate lock at the boat ramp/dock, please contact Dockmaster Rocky Boykin at 804-898-2052.

Just a Reminder ...

Beginning July 1, 2016, all PWC operators age 14 and older and all motorboat operators, regardless of age, need to take a boating safety course and will be required to carry a boating safety education course completion card in order to operate a PWC or boat with a 10 hp or greater motor.
