

Ordinance No. *564*

An ordinance designating to whom the taxes ~~provided~~ ^{shall be paid} for ~~by~~ in chapter 248 of the laws of 1911, and to provide penalties for failure to comply with the provisions of of said law and this ordinance.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Commissioners of the City of Garnett, Sec. 1. That all taxes ^{due the city of Garnett} provided for by section 36. of Chapter 248 of the

laws of 1911, shall be paid to the City Clerk, who is authorized to receipt for the same, and who shall as soon as the same are paid into his hands ~~turn~~ turn them over to the city treasurer for the bennefit of the Street fund of said City.

Sec. 2. It shall be the duty of the City clerk as soon as possible after the 1st. day of May of each year, obtain from the County Clerk of Anderson County, the names of all persons ^{in said city} liable to pay said tax for the year then ensuing. and to immediately ~~mail~~ ^{serve by delivering} a notice in writing ~~to~~ on each of said persons, that said tax is due, which said notice may be served in the manner provided by law for serving summonses, in court proceedings, ~~by~~ by the said city clerk ~~or~~ ^{or} the city marshall, a duplicate of which notice shall be kept by the city clerk. ~~or~~ other person serving the same.

Sec. 3. Any person liable to pay said tax in the city of Garnett, who shall fail for thirty days ^{to pay the same} after being notified as herein provided, shall ~~be~~ ^{be} deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and on conviction shall be fined in ~~the~~ ^{the} sum of not less than Three dollars nor more than Five Dollars. Provided that the payment of said fine shall not exempt any such person, from paying said tax, nor from being again notified and again arrested and fined as herein provided, after failure to pay.

Sec. 4. All fines under this ordinance shall be paid into the street fund of said city.

Sec. 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be inforce according to law, after its ^{final} passage and approval.
