Regular Meeting -----June 2, 1987

The meeting was called to order by the Chairman, D. L. Taylor at 7:00 A.M. Other Grand County Water Conservancy District members present were Gary Wilson and John Groo  
Grand County Special Service District members present were D. L. Taylor, A. Dan Holyoak, Gary Wilson and William D. McDougald.

ATTENDANCE

Others present were Don Maynard, Dale Pierson and Roberta Highland.

Roberta read the minutes of the meeting of May 19, 1987. After calling for additions or corrections, the chair declared the minutes approved as read.

MINUTES

Dale reported the Golf Course Board would attend the next meeting, they have signed and returned the Letter of Intent.

GOLF COURSE BOARD

D. L. asked about the problem of the proposed golf course being adjacent to the City Springs. Dale displayed the map of the proposed golf course, including the old course and the protection zone. He reported that under the Safe Drinking Water act, any changes have to be reported to the Bureau of Drinking Water, The plans should have been submitted before any work had been done, and since that had not been done, when construction on the new course started the City of Moab is now out of compliance. The plan is to invite some of the engineering staff from the Drinking Water Staff down for a consultation.

GOLF COURSE EXTENSION

Dale stated he felt the pipeline should proceed because of the fact we could water the existing 9 holes, and if they move the other 9 holes and housing, the fact of an existing pipeline would be an asset to the project. The amendments to the Safe Drinking Water Act was discussed.

Proposed development was discussed, Dale pointed out that this District also must watch Johnson's Up On Top, that if the State leases it to the Sports Development Center it might encroach upon our protection zone for George White Well #4.

PROPOSED DEVELOPMENT

Dale explained he had asked Elaine Matthews about the easement and the pipe has been delivered. The project is on schedule.

Don asked about the meter put on his line last year, and stated the meter had reduced his flow. When he had turned his system on, it had not given him the flow he had had in the past. He reported that he had a leak, but the break had been caused when the line was crossed. the hydraulics of reducing line size for a smaller meter was discussed, and Don recommended that lines not be necked down for a meter, because the flows are restricted. Mr. Maynard was thanked for his input.




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The meeting adjourned at 7:50 A. M.
