This is functional good news, as our organ, a Moller creation, is quite well known to local players, instrument aficionados, and technicians as one of the best church organs in the entire Susquehanna Valley.

But there's more to tell.

We were fortunate to have skilled performers at the Moller keyboard over its whole life, and Merle Nicholas, certainly one of the best of them, recently brought us some packets of technical and special performance information, specifications, and blueprints that document the history and construction of the organ.

This is an extremely valuable collection of material that we will archive in the safest of places, and we thank Merle for his thoughtfulness in making these artifacts available to Bethany.


