Victor F. Gremel, 65, Belong Sebewasing resident, died unexpectedly Wednesday morning, Feb. 23, at Bay Medical Center, Bay City.

He was born Feb. 25, 1928, in Sebewasing, the son of Ferdinand and Ida (Pobenz) Gremel. He was married to Nancy Gillingham in Sebewasing on Aug. 26, 1949. She survives him.

As a member of the Armed Services, he served two years in the Merchant Marine and later two years in the U.S. Navy during World War II.

Mr. Gremel was a dedicated member of the Sebewasing community. He worked as a mechanic for Sebewasing Gas and Oil Company for 17 years. He was a life member of Sebewasing VFW Post #4115. Mr. Gremel was a member of Sebewasing Volunteer Fire Department for 25 years and served as fire chief for many of those years. He was a police officer for several years and later was street commissioner for Sebewasing Village until his retirement in 1985. Mr. Gremel was one of the organizers of Sebewasing Ambulance Service.

Mr. Gremel was a member of Immanuel Lutheran Church of Sebewasing, and had served on the Board of Evangelism.
