I saw your above mentioned patient 3-29-95. You recall this is a 18 year old senior in high school with episodes of explosive behavior. He admits to having a very bad temper.

This appears to stem primarily from his difficulty with relationships with girls. He recently experienced a break up with a girlfriend that he is still very obsessive about. He does indeed have a lot of anger.

He does have an interesting history in that he was apparently seduced by a dance teacher when he was 13 and continued this relationship for about a year and a half. He feels that this harmed his reputation so local girls are afraid to go out with him.

I sent him home with an MMPI to be completed for diagnostic clarity. I feel I established good rapport with him. He is to return in one week.
