Ordinance No. *15-9*

An Ordinance relating to certain misdemeanors.

Be it Ordained by the Mayor and Councilmen of the city of Garnett, Kansas:-

Section 1. That it shall be unlawful for any person or persons at, in or on any sidewalk, street, street crossing, avenue, alley, ~~area~~ area, park or other public grounds, or ^{any} vacant lot in said city of Garnett, Kansas, to play at ball, either by throwing, catching or striking the same or in any other manner, or to play at cards of any kind, marbles, dice, or any other game or games of chance of any kind or however played, whether played for amusement merely or otherwise.

Sec. 2. That it shall be unlawful for any person or persons, at or in said City of Garnett, Kansas, to play at the game commonly called "Baseball" or any similar game or games played with balls and bats.

Sec. 3. That it shall be unlawful for any person or persons to loaf or loiter about, in or on any park or other public grounds in said city of Garnett, Kansas, between the hours of ten o'clock ~~P.M.~~ P.M. and seven o'clock A.M., and any person or persons being about in or on any park or public grounds of said city between the hours named, without giving a good account of themselves, shall be held to have violated this section of this ordinance.

Sec. 4. That any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor; and upon conviction ~~there~~ therefor shall be punished for the first offense by a fine of not less One Dollar (\$1.00.) nor more than Twenty Five Dollars (\$25.00) or imprisonment in the city jail not less than Five days nor more than twenty days, or both such fine and imprisonment, and for every ~~subsequent~~ subsequent offense by a fine of not less than five dollars (\$5.00) nor more than fifty dollars (\$50.00.) and imprisonment in the city jail not less than ten days nor more than forty days.

Sec. 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the *Garnett Eagle, Garnett Journal*
