Water Plant Operations Manager

This full time Water Plant Operations Manager position will oversee the day-to-day operations of the Hap Cremean Water Plant (HCWP) and will supervise eleven water plant operators and three instrument technicians and act as the plant manager in his/her absence. It will ensure that all operational and compliance testing is completed as required by the Ohio EPA and oversee chemical shipments, chemical dosages and equipment calibrations necessary to effectively manage each process in the treatment plant. It will also provide support to the Plant Manager to ensure the Water Plant, Utilities Department and City of Columbus Administration action plans, goals and objectives are carried out.

The HCWP is a class IV surface water plant and is Columbus' largest plant that can produce up to 125 million gallons per day of safe drinking water through conventional two-stage lime softening and ozone/biologically active filtration. This water treatment facility is currently installing stand-by power, UV disinfection and converting to sodium hypochlorite disinfection.

To be considered for this position, candidates must possess two (2) years' experience leading and participating in monitoring, operating, and controlling water treatment processes in a water plant rated Class III or higher; Possession of a valid Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) State of Ohio Class III or IV Water Supply Operator certificate for water treatment works. And, possession of a valid motor vehicle operator's license. The salary range for this position is: \$72,605 - \$108,884 annually.
