

## Design Guide – Classroom



### Classroom

A corporate classroom will be used for training, seminars, briefings and presentations. The system needs to be capable of displaying both digital and analog source types in a high quality, professional manner. The lectern/front desk will have one HDMI and one analog VGA input available to the presenter as well as a resident network PC. Inputs will be capable of supporting signals up to 4K. There will also be a preview monitor where the lecturer can preview the display before sending the content through to the main projector. In a central equipment area, there will be a TV receiver and a Blu-ray player.

Delegates can present wirelessly by accessing the Crestron AirMedia wireless gateway whilst audio is picked up from 2 ceiling microphones and sent to 4 ceiling speakers.

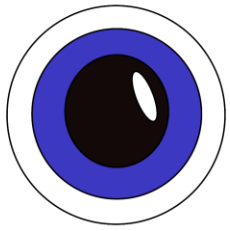
The room can be controlled from a single 7" Touch Panel or perhaps a larger iOS or Android tablet.

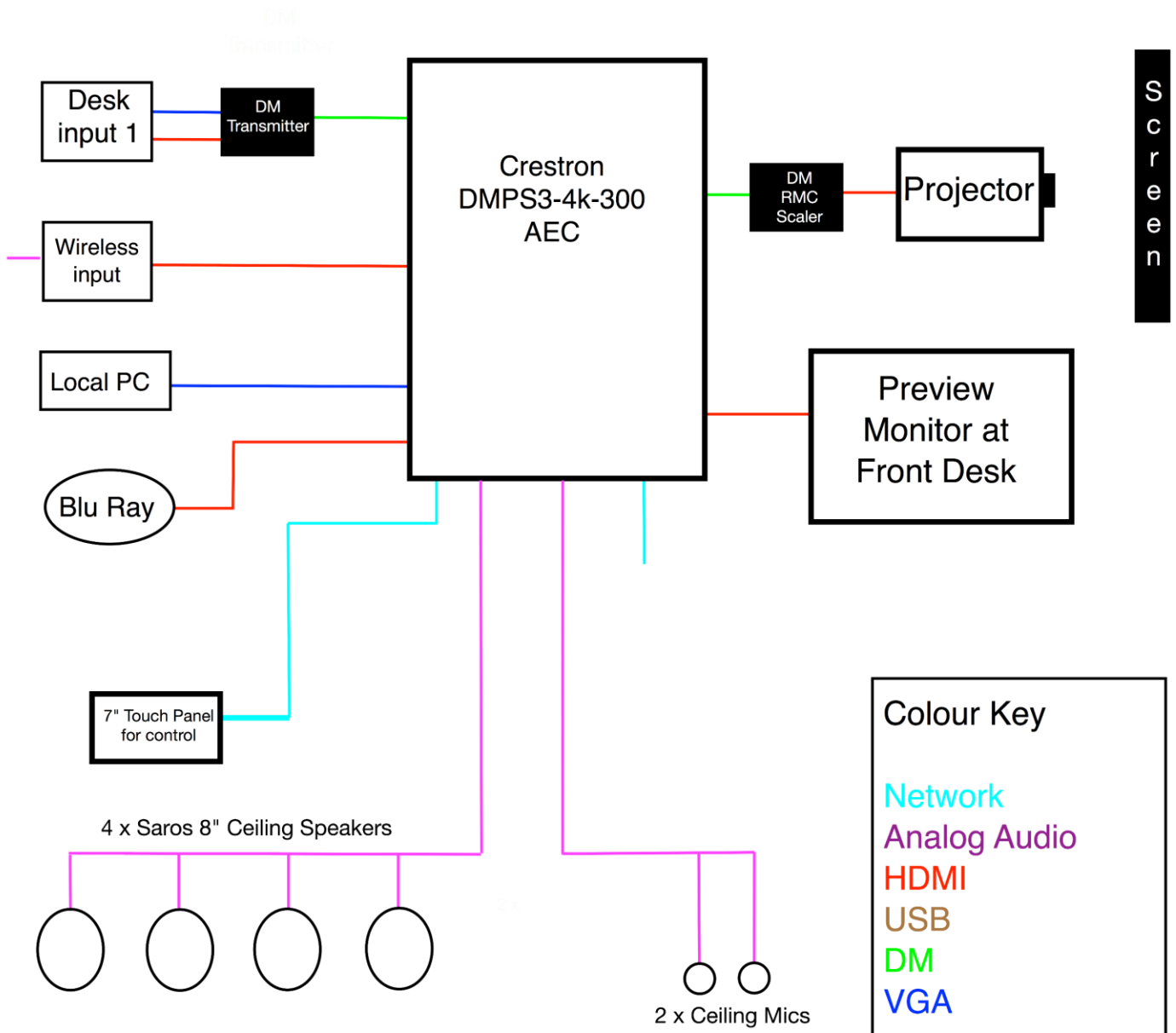
