A Civil War style commemoration for Peter Bottineau, son of Pierre Bottineau a well-known early pioneer and Minnesota legend. Peter served three plus years in the 5th Minnesota Infantry and signed up as a veteran to serve an additional three years. The 5th fought in numerous battles and marched thousands of miles in the heat and humidity of the deep South. Corporal Bottineau became ill in early 1865 and was sent home to recuperate and ultimately succumbed to scarlet fever.

- . and a eulogy by author and historian Fritz Anderson.
