PASSES AWAY

Mrs. Lena Anklam died at her home in this village at 12:15 Sunday morning following an illness of about six weeks.

Magdalena Fettig was born in Baden, Germany, on September 18, 1859. When eleven years of age she came to this country with her parents and settled in Saginaw. In the year 1878 she was united in marriage to August Anklam and one year following they took up their home on a farm one mile south and one mile west of Pigeon. farm until 1912 when she moved to Pigeon where she spent the balance of her life.

The funeral services were conducted at the Berne Lutheran church Wednesday afternoon by Rev. Wacker and the remains were laid to rest beside those of her husband in the Pigeon cemetery.

Deceased was the mother of nine children, five of whom survive her. Those living are: three daughters, Mrs. Lydia Maier, of Saginaw, Mrs. Anna Notter, of Flint and Mrs. Frances Buerker, of Pigeon; two sons, George, of Battie Creek and Edward of Pigeon. Fifteen grand children and three great grand children; three brothers, John and Leo Fettig of Saginaw and Charles Fettig, of Marlette also survive her.

Mrs. Anklam was of a kind and pleasant disposition, a good mother and a loyal friend. She was one of the township's best known women.
