FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Will there be an alternative rain date?

No, this event will be held rain or shine. In the event of inclement weather, we will move into indoor facilities at the center.

What items are allowed/not allowed at this event?

ITEMS ALLOWED INCLUDE:

- Lawn chairs
- Blankets
- Rain coats and ponchos
- Umbrellas

PROHIBITED ITEMS INCLUDE:

- Coolers (except at camp sites)
- Food & beverages (except at camp sites)
- Pets
- Weapons

Will tickets be available for purchase at the gate on the day of the show?

Yes, but we prefer you purchase in advance. Tickets are available for sale at <http://bit.ly/MillstoneEvents>. Click on the red 'Buy Tickets' button at the top of the web page to purchase tickets with a credit card. Online ticket sales will close at noon on Oct. 20. After noon on Oct. 20, all tickets can be purchased by cash, credit or check at the gate.

Is a ticket stub required?

Tickets are required for any and all purchases that were made by cash or check. If your tickets were purchased by credit, the paper tickets are preferred for entry but we will have an electronic list of attendees for any tickets that have been purchased specifically with credit cards. Tickets purchased by credit will be available for Will Call pick-up at the gate. Tickets purchased by cash or credit will be given to you upon purchase.

Can my guests arrive separately?

You and your guests may arrive separately, as long as we have your guests' names for registration. We recommend you purchase your tickets by credit if you plan to bring guests so that we have an electronic record of your guests' names. If you purchase your tickets by check or cash, each guest must present their own ticket at the gate.

Why is this an adult-only event?

The event is designed as an opportunity for adults to come out and relax while listening to great music and enjoying good food and company. Beer and wine are included as part of the ticket price.

Is there available lodging on the premises?
