DESCRIPTION: This is a **very rare** Groves Spitfire Prestige Special. This bow is actual a take-down model which is why it was named the Prestige Special. The take-down is not in the limbs, but the bottom half of the riser (thus the green and white diagonal line in the bottom half of the riser. You can see the bolt in the back. This bow came in one-piece when I acquired it, and I have not tried to take it down, so I cannot speak as to whether the bolt is frozen or how readily it can be taken-down. The bow will be shipped as a one-piece. This is a very heavy bow (mass weight) - about 4.3 pounds. The large heavy riser absorbs almost all shock and makes for a very smooth shot. Beautiful Rosewood and Ebony riser. Bow has had some repairs (filled screw holes, tip overlay replacement and repair—see pics), no cracks; limbs are straight. Overdraw arrow shelf. Overlays and tips are in good condition (see pics). No chips, dings or cracks. No crazing or stress cracks; A few minor scratches and nicks here and there. Decal and specs are in very good shape. Comes with the vintage Bear rest shown (Don't know if this was aftermarket or if Groves used this Bear rest as its standard rest).

Comes with a new string.
