

AMELIA VILLAGE, OHIO
Ordinance O-2014-13

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH STRATUS BUILDING SOLUTIONS FOR CLEANING SERVICES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, The Village is in need of cleaning services as needed for its administrative offices; and

WHEREAS, Stratus Building Solutions, is willing and able to provide cleaning services as needed and requested by the Village; and

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of Amelia Village, Ohio that:

SECTION I: Village Council accepts the recommendation of the Mayor that the Village contract with Stratus Building Solutions for cleaning services at a cost of \$45.00 (forty five dollars) per week, on a weekly basis.

SECTION II: The Mayor and the Fiscal Officer are hereby authorized and directed to execute the Agreement on behalf of the Village to secure the necessary cleaning services from Stratus Building Solutions, substantially in form attached hereto as Exhibit A.

SECTION III: This ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of Amelia Village and its inhabitants. Therefore, this ordinance shall become effective upon its adoption.

SECTION IV: Village Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of its committees, if any, which resulted in formal action, were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with applicable legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

MR. CAMPBELL moved to suspend the rules requiring three readings on three separate dates.
