**YOUTH MINISTRIES
CODE OF CONDUCT**

GENERAL

1. TREAT OTHERS AS YOU WOULD HAVE THEM TREAT YOU (THE GOLDEN RULE)
2. USE OF PROFANITY PROHIBITED
3. THERE WILL BE NO FIGHTING, EITHER VERBAL OR PHYSICAL
4. ALL STUDENTS WILL RESPECT AND OBEY ALL ADULTS AND STAFF WHILE AT, OR EN ROUTE TO OR FROM CHURCH OR ANY FUNCTION

BUS (OR OTHER DESIGNATED VEHICLE)

1. ALL STUDENTS WILL MAINTAIN A LOW NOISE LEVEL SO AS TO NOT HINDER THE DRIVER'S ABILITY TO SAFELY OPERATE THE VEHICLE. THIS INCLUDES ANY VEHICLE USED FOR CHURCH OPERATION
2. STUDENTS WILL LISTEN TO AND OBEY ALL STAFF WHILE A PASSENGER IN A CHURCH OPERATED VEHICLE AND WHILE ON CHURCH PREMISES.
3. ALL PASSENGERS WILL WEAR SEAT BELTS AND/OR ANY RESTRAINTS REQUIRED BY VEHICLE FOR SAFE OPERATION
4. THE WAY A STUDENT ARRIVES AT A CHURCH FUNCTION WILL BE THE WAY THEY LEAVE UNLESS SPECIFICALLY AUTHORIZED BY THE PARENT OR LEGAL GUARDIAN, AND RELAYED TO THE STAFF PRIOR TO THE FUNCTION (E.G. IF A STUDENT IS PICKED UP BY THE BUS, THEY WILL BE BROUGHT HOME THE SAME WAY)

ANY VIOLATION OF THE ABOVE LISTED RULES WILL BE DEALT WITH AS FOLLOWS:

1st Offense: Verbal Warning

2nd Offense: Phone and/or personal contact with parent/guardian

3rd Offense: Suspension from program in which violation occurred

4th Offense: There will be a meeting with leadership and parents to discuss student's future within the program

*** Any and all instances involving violence, defiance or disrespect of a leader, and sexual misconduct will be dealt with on a case by case basis. ***

Please understand that it is not our intent or desire for anyone to be asked to leave one of our programs. However, for the sake of others so that their learning may not be hindered or that they be placed in danger by the actions of others, we will take any actions necessary to ensure the safety and well being of our students.
