

Wilson Contractors wins the Open category at the Southland CCNZ Construction Awards



Wilson Contractors won the Open award for the Windsor Street Stormwater and Foul Sewer Renewals project at the CCNZ Construction Awards for the Southland Branch on Friday 27th October.



The project, located on Windsor Street in Invercargill, involved the renewal of 365m of foul sewer main and 391m of stormwater main in one of Invercargill's busiest mixed residential and retail areas. The event, held at the Bill Richardson Transport Museum, was attended by more than 100 guests. Wilson Contractors won the award, beating a number of other contractors in the Open category.

Andy Sinclair, Invercargill Contract Manager said "it's a real honour to receive this award and is recognition of the hard work put in by the team to ensure the safe completion of the project in a very busy retail and residential location".

The award recognised the high level of health and safety required in such a busy location and the positive impact of constant communication with retail owners and local residents.



This was achieved by holding an open day in conjunction with ICC, where families could see up close what actually happens on the site and children could sit in the diggers and trucks.
