

Project Update and Nominations

To date we have raised \$18,690 for our Project. See our Project Promoter's challenge to us for a new "Goal" of \$20,000 for Texas Missions. We would need to raise a little over \$21,000 for us to be able to give Texas Missions \$20,000 for Bibles and other study material. 10 % of our project money goes into our General and Youth Funds.

We have received 3 project nominations that we will vote on at our State meeting on November 7 to be our project for next year. The officers thought that it would be helpful for you to know what these nominations are before you get to the state meeting. This way you can present them to your local ladies group and discuss and pray about which project to vote for.

Project Nominations for 2023-2024

All projects are 90%, 10% of money raised goes into our General and Youth funds

1. Lake Highlands, Sulphur Springs is recommending Tammy and Larry Wood Ukraine Work Fund for the project. This will be to support 3 church plants in Ukraine.

1)Water of Life, Lutsk needs money for supplies, food, and shelter for the displaced refugees coming to Western Ukraine.

2)Grace Church, Volodymyr needs money for supplies for soldiers (each soldier is responsible for purchase for all purchase all of their gear). Then they take boots, uniforms, coats, etc. to the front lines and distribute them as well as share the Gospel.


- 3)Retreat Center, Zaozerne needs money for mattresses and covers for 120 bed facility. This is housing refugees and helping them to find another home or go to another country. They also feed and clothe and give them spiritual guidance while they are there living life with them.
- 2. Red Springs, Tyler WMA is recommending Jacksonville College Chapel air-conditioning for the project. Jacksonville College is a true Mission Field. They have students from several countries there that need to know the Lord. Their air conditioning is in bad shape in several buildings. They have received some help but the cost is more than \$80,000.
- 3. FBC, Maydelle nominates Rose Ng/High City—BMA Teach for Christ for the project. To meet the nutritional needs of 16 children attending Bible study in the Village of Thanh Due, Vietnam in the amount of \$850.00 a month.
