

NEW RULES

74th Street Lakefill

EFFECTIVE JUNE 1, 2020

The 74th Street Lakefill only accepts Clean Fill, as defined by Chapter 24 of Miami-Dade County Code.

Miami-Dade DERM is requiring that all material be submitted for their review prior to being accepted at the lakefill. All customers will be responsible for submitting DERM material acceptance requests.

Step 1 – Complete and submit the attached “DERM Lakefill Material Acceptance Form” to DERM. This form must be submitted to DERM at least 3 business days before material is scheduled to be delivered to the lakefill.

Step 2 – Show a copy of the completed form with DERM’s approval with each load delivered to the lakefill. The material types and delivery dates must match the approved form.

Photos must be time-stamped, and a landmark or similar marker must be included in the faraway photo to show the location.

Notes:

1. This form with attachments shall be submitted to DERM (the Miami-Dade County Department of Regulatory and Economic Resources, Division of Environmental Resources Management). Depending on the source and/or characteristics of the fill material, DERM may require the submittal of additional supporting information prior to rendering an acceptance decision. DERM reserves the right to inspect the source site to verify the submitted information, assess the condition of the fill material and/or evaluate the adequacy of segregation activities.
2. A copy of this form with DERM's approval shall be provided at the lakefill entrance. The material type and delivery dates must match.
3. Soil must be separately approved by DERM in accordance with their Soil Reuse Guidance for Miami-DadeCounty. The guidance is available online. A request for a Soil Reuse Determination must be submitted 30 days before delivery of material.
