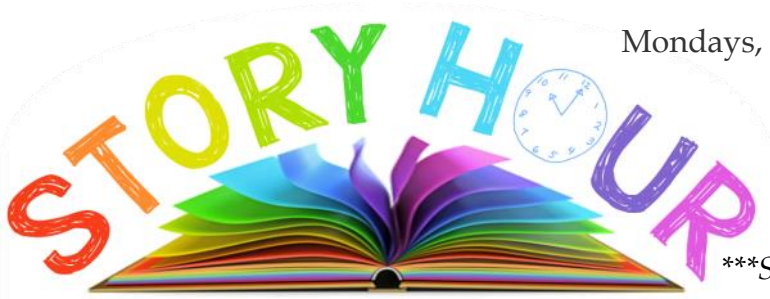


Medicare 101

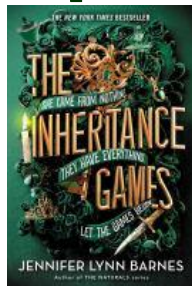

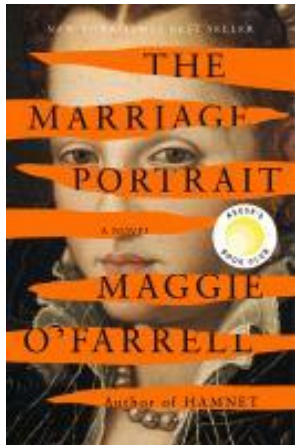

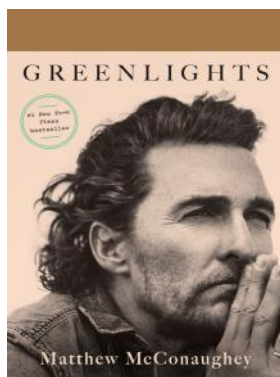
