The Sales Tax will be a question for the public and the money will be used for various funds that the tax applies too such as the Sheriff's office, Prosecuting Attorney's office, Victims Advocate and the Coroner. There have been conversations with several of the schools in the County concerning the need for resource officers. The officers would be funded partially by the County and the Schools if all are agreeable. The issues will be 2 separate ballot questions. These issues were brought to the Commission as needs from the Prosecuting Attorney and the Sheriff.

The Commission approved a patron to set up a table on the Courthouse Lawn the weekend of the City wide garage sales which will have information concerning employment with the school bus service.

Stephanie Williams, NCMBF met with the Commission to give them an update on her organization and to thanks the Commission these past few years for their support.

Adam Watson, MODOT contacted the Commission concerning the shoulder's on J, O and N. The maintenance crew will be out in the next few months to address the issues. No timeline was given.
